Churchill and A Streak of Rita Crowned Canadian Champs

With over \$11,000 dollars available in each of 6 rounds and the average this last week, the Canadian Finals Rodeo in Edmonton, AB November 9-13, 2011 are a must stop attraction for all professional barrel racers.

With that much money up, you know the competition was going to be stiff but could you imagine that on Sunday after noon three ladies would all have the chance to be champion. It was simple, win the final round and you are the Canadian Professional Rodeo Champion.

Coming into the Canadian Finals Rodeo (CFR) Trula Churchill led the standings with \$27,092 of earnings. She and her mount, A Streak Of Rita, started off the CFR consistently placing second or third in the first four rounds. Meanwhile, Lisa Lockhart and An Oakie With Cash were getting warmed up. They closed the gap winning Round 2 and then Round 5, the veteran competitor wasn't going to let Churchill out of her sights. All the while, 2009 Canadian champion Gaylene Buff and Dat Blue Moon were using Round wins 3 & 4 to jump her up into the lead going into that final round.

On that final Sunday afternoon the barrels were run from the top to the bottom with a hand rake in between each run. First up was Buff, she ran a fast clean 14.657 and put herself in the drivers seat, they were going to have to bring their best if they wanted a title in Canada.

Churchil was next to run, she knew her horse was sitting on a good run and he blew threw the pattern in a quick 14.508. The only thing standing between her now and a championship was the ice cold competitor and 2 Time Canadian Champ Lisa Lockhart. Lockhart laid down a run and the clock read 14.553. It was decided by less than 0.05 seconds, Churchill won the round and the championship.

These three combined won 5 out of the 6 rounds and were the top 3 in the average. Only Lindsay Sears and Ima Guy Of Honor with their Round 1 win were able to break the Churchill/Lockhart/Buff stronghold at the CFR.

We caught up with Churchill to find out just a little more about her and her championship.

Trula Churchill & A Streak Of Rita (Worm)

BRR: Tell us a little about the history A Streak Of Rita and his approximate lifetime earnings.

Churchill: I raised Worm, his mom was a bulldogging horse that went to the 2000 NFR with Chad Cadwell. I was there 30 minutes after he was born and he was dirty and kind of brown colored when I saw him and looked like a worm so I called him Worm. I did all the barrel training on him, Joe Butterfield put 60 days on him as a 2 year old to start him. As a 4 year old, I ran him at Ft Smith, the Cornhusker Futurity, 5 State Breeders Futurity and the Hawki Futurity and he won money at all of them. He actually ran the second

fastest qualifying time at Ft Smith, won a round at Cornhusker, was second at the 5 States, and also at the Hawki. He went to 4 rodeos as a 4 year old, he placed at Billings and split the win at Casper. As a 5 year old we ended up 30th in the world and only went to rodeos from June 1 until the middle of August when I had to go back


to school (work) and only went to 30-35 rodeos total. He also won 2nd Tour Final Omaha in 2010. In 2011, we ended up 23rd in the PRCA/WPRA standings and we were leading the CPRA Standings going into the CFR and ended up being Year End Champion. We were 2nd in the Average at the CFR. His approximate lifetime earnings are about \$170,000 and he hasn't really been hauled a lot yet.

New Bill Clears the Way for Horse Processing Facilities

Washington, D.C. - Last night, November 14, 2011, the Conference Committee on HR 2112 consolidated appropriations for Agriculture, Commerce-Justice-Science and Transportation - Housing and Urban Development signed a conference report resolving differences between the House and Senate versions of the bill that for the first time since 2005 does not contain annual riders that prohibit USDA from providing necessary inspection for horse processing facilities.

The International Equine Business Association (IEBA) is a new association that is an outcome of the alliances that United Horsemen has formed with hundreds of entities like the National Tribal Horse Coalition, Charros Federation USA, horse councils, production agriculture, pet animal and animal entertainment groups, as well as international partners like the Horse Welfare Alliance of Canada. The Association is eager to work with equine businesses, organizations, state, tribal, and federal agencies to maximize this opportunity.

"We could not be more pleased," says IEBA U.S co-chair Sue Wallis, "and grateful to our many partners and supporters to once again have a clear path to increase the welfare of horses, reinvigorate the devastated horse related economy, and promote the ethical, appropriate use of horses that will be welcomed by a worldwide and domestic market, create jobs, and preserve our beloved horseback American culture for our children and grandchildren. The now devastated horse industry looks forward to the day when we can once again contribute more than \$1.9 Billion dollars in tax revenue nationwide from an industry that prior to 2007 was a \$102 Billion dollar sector of animal agriculture...to once again supporting 1.4 Million full-time jobs working with horses everyday."

The tide turned for the horse industry when Congress received a report from their research office that looked into the effect of the closure of the U.S. horse processing facilities. That Government Accountability Office (GAO) report, HORSE WELFARE: Action Needed to Address Unintended Consequences of Domestic Slaughter Cessation, documents the decline in horse welfare, and the negative impacts on the overall equine economy as a direct result of the loss of a humane option for otherwise unwanted, unusable, excess horses.

Because of the back-door exclusionary efforts of the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS), Congress adopted the first of these damaging appropriations riders in 2005, with more added in 2007 that have prevented any facilities from operating in the forty-six states that do not have state law preventing them.

"That roadblock is now removed," noted Wallis, "now we shift our focus to resuming profitable legitimate businesses in the horse industry, and a return of normal markets for horses at every level, and every sector of the diverse horse world."

The IEBA is positioned to promote and encourage equine harvesting businesses that are held to high humane handling and food safety standards, in order to bring quality products to a vibrant and viable worldwide market. IEBA will be providing legal defense, political advocacy, business consulting, technological solutions, and more for all aspects of the equine industry.

Crazy Horse Supporter Anne Ziolkowski Honored

Anne Ziolkowski Christensen was posthumously given the Ben Kobza Award by the Badlands Circuit this fall for her contributions to rodeo. "Anne Z," who died in May of this year, was the driving force behind the PRCA's Crazy Horse Stampede in Crazy Horse, S.D. She grew up the sixth of 10 children of Korczak and Ruth Ziolkowski, the sculptors of the Crazy Horse mountain carving in progress. Anne, along with several of her siblings, worked at their father's life goal: to complete a monument honoring the North American Indian people. She oversaw the operations of the Indian Museum of North America and its gifts shops at the Memorial, as well as the special events on the Crazy Horse grounds. Anne loved horses and cowboys, and she was the visionary who worked to incorporate a PRCA rodeo alongside the Great Plains Indian Rodeo Association events that are held in mid-June.

Churchill: I just had to let him do his thing and trust him. I took him in Wednesday and they let us go around the barrels, I loped him around the barrels a couple times and he was comfortable with the arena and the surroundings so I didn't take him back in there all week even though we could get in the arena each day if we chose to. He was just so focused and relaxed I didn't want to mess him up. In the 5th round, he fired so hard to the first barrel, he set and turned so hard he almost came back over the top of the barrel. I had to pick him up and over. It was kind of a downer because I messed him up but it was nice that I was able to pick him up and move him over going that fast. He just hesitated and took a step out. It looked like he tripped but it was just a hesitation.

BRR: You knew the situation going into the final round, you had to win to win the year end championship, how did you handle that?

Churchill: I just tried to keep my mind on what I had to do. I just tried to not worry about the standings. Lynn (my husband) told me to just keep doing your deal. Even though I tried not to focus on it, I knew whoever did the best that day would win because in the opening of the rodeo they were talking about it. I knew it was close between us three. I knew I just had to go in and make the best run I can make and not worry about what everyone else was going to do. In the final go, they ran it from 1-12 so Gaylene was first, I was second, and Lisa was third on the ground and they hand raked after every girl. You could place from any position on the ground, and the ground had been consistent all week so I knew that wouldn't be a factor, so I just had to make my best run.



Pedone and Kiss This Guy Capture JB Quarter Horses Futurity

The 3rd Annual JB Quarter Horses Futurity, held Nov. 10-13 in conjunction with the 3rd Annual JB Quarter Horses Creating Legends Sale and Elite Extravaganza at the Extraco Center in Waco, Texas, drew 118 entries for \$48,321 total purse of which \$20,000 was added.

Of those 118 entries, 18 were amateurs running for \$6,088 of which \$5,000 was generously added by Copper Spring Ranch of Bozeman, Mont.

Using the format pioneered by JB Quarter Horses, the field was split in half during a qualifying round held on Thursday night. The top half qualified for the \$28,993 Championship Round on Saturday night and the bottom half ran for \$19,328 in the Consolation Round on Friday night.

In the Championship Round, Ryann Pedone and her home-raised Kiss This Guy, now owned by National Finals Rodeo qualifier Carlee Pierce, continued their winning ways posting a 15.191 for the \$6,088 victory. In the Consolation, former NFR qualifier Shelley Morgan and Will Merada posted a 15.341 to claim \$4,059. Bobbi Pradon and TB Rowdy Bug had the best two-run aggregate to win the amateur title and \$3,060.

Championship

"He's been really, really good to me," said an excited Ryann Pedone of Kiss This Guy ("Tyson"). "If he was a human, I'd say that I owe him a kidney!"

Pedone, a Florida native who moved to Decatur, Texas, in 2006, was concerned that Tyson didn't have enough runs coming to the JB Quarter Horses Futurity because he'd come up sore after taking a bad step in the slot race the WPRA Finals in October.

"He'd been off for 10 days," she said. "When I got back from Lincoln he was really, really sore. When I got him home, Dr. (Josh) Harvey fixed him up and got him feeling well. I wasn't expecting him to do as well here because he'd been off. Usually, he's better with a couple of runs."

As it turns out, two runs were enough to get the 4-year-old BHR Frenchies Socks gelding firing.

Tyson has been a super performer through the late summer and fall. He's a Win More open 1D champion, a reserve champion at the Fizz Bomb Futurity, a finalist at Jud Little's Bar Nothin Barrel Bash Futurity and the WPRA Finals, just to name a few.

He's also known for running the fastest time of the weekend at several events. It was after he did just that en route to a win in the \$10,000-added Open at Little's Barrel Bash that Carlee Pierce decided to purchase the gelding.

Pedone will have Tyson through the BFA World Championships the first week of December.

"Right after BFA, I have to have knee surgery," said Pedone, who injured her knee at the WinMore event in August. "I tore my ACL when I was getting on, just pure clumsiness."

One thing is for certain--there has been nothing faulty with Pedone's breeding program—one that she's cultivated with the help of her partner Josh Harvey, DVM, of Outlaw Equine in Decatur.

"He was the one that kept the broodmares going and now they're finally starting to pay for themselves," said Pedone. "It's hard for someone like me, when you're trying to build a business to get those broodmares and raise those babies when you can buy them cheaper than you can raise them. He's been a really good partner."

Their cornerstone mare is Tyson's dam, Kiss Kiss This, a daughter of Chain Of Events which carried Jody (Nelson) Dorman to the 1997 NBHA Youth 1D World Championship. Pedone bought the mare from her dad before moving to Texas.

She sold the mare's first foal, Cause For A Kiss, by the On The Money Red stallion Cause Its Money, after the BFA Juvenile last year.

"This is our second crop and Ty's done more than enough for us," she said. "T've got some half brothers to him. I have a Confederate Leader. I've got a full brother to Cause For A Kiss. I've got A Streak Of Fling in the belly. Next year, I'm going to flush her to Firewater-onrocks and breed her back to BHR Frenchies Socks."

Pedone, who is just coming into her own as a barrel horse trainer, wanted to thank all the people who have made it possible—Josh Harvey, Art and Bonnie Ray for breaking all her colts, reiners Alan and Wendy Parker, Sid Myers, Alan Stanley, Crystal Shumate and Derek Piel, Jaye Johnson and Classic Equine, her dad, her mom and step dad, and "a lot of people that I've probably forgot!"

Consolation

In a field stacked with towering, muscle-bound Dash Ta Fames, it was the fluid, flawless turns of a cutting-bred reject that everyone was talking about—Shelley Morgan's Will Merada ("Radar"). The 4-year-old chestnut gelding by Light N Lena out of Meradas Oh Kay, by Freckles Merada, clocked a 15.138 but pulled over the third barrel in the qualifying round. They came back to win the consolation in 15.341.

While other horses were flying into the first barrel, Radar was merely going three-quarter speed.

"I keep him under control," said the 2009 National Finals Rodeo qualifier from Eustace, Texas. "Actually yesterday was the fastest I've sent him in a long time. I don't even think he knows how to run yet. I think when I really get him working good and consistent, I'm going take him somewhere and breeze him."

Asking for more speed sounds a little crazy for a horse that earned

his first paycheck in the his second competition run ever—the Cody, Wyoming's Fourth of July Stampede pro rodeo. His first run was the second round at the Greeley Independence Stampede pro rodeo.

"I hit the first barrel on my other horse in the first round (in Greeley), so I was already out of the average," she said. "I was able to get in the pen that night and work him, so I ran him the next day. We got by the first barrel, but he still clocked. I went straight to Cody, Wyo. I got up at 5 in the morning and worked him in that pen. I ran him there and placed. I also placed at Livingston, Mont. He ran the fastest time at Mobridge, but hit the second barrel. I'm really excited about him."

Morgan's dad, Bobby Birdwell, who finds all her horse, bought Radar. She was so busy training other horses that her dad had to convince her to ride him. When she started him in the spring, Radar took to the pattern instantly.


Morgan's husband, Rex, was the one that pushed her to enter the futurity. Even with the NFR under her belt, Morgan found the futurity at little intimidating.

"Yesterday I was little nervous," she said. "I know I've been to rodeos and stuff, but I'm new to this. Sometimes when I'm on a new horse, I tend to get a little nervous and forget to have fun. On our way here today (for the Consolation), I told my husband that I was just going to send him, be aggressive and let him do his job. I was going to stay relaxed because he's only 4, and when I'm nervous, he knows it. I have to relax for him."

Never in a million years did Morgan think that she would have another superstar in her barn so quickly after she lost her beloved NFR horse My Playboy Champ ("Short Go").

"I lost him in February 2010 and its November 2011," she said. "I'll never replace Short Go. We have some rounds from the NFR saved. Just last week, I was sitting on the couch watching them just bawling my eyes out. He had the biggest heart and was as honest

as they come. I know we hit a few barrels, but it was usually on the backside because he was trying so hard.

"To get one trained is one thing, to get them running and you with them is another thing, and then to get them running at the rodeos is something else entirely. It's just hard. When I lost Short Go, I was thinking it was going to be at least four or five years down the road. I never did think I would have this. I know God had to have a hand in this."

With Radar and Frenchmans Flirt, owned by Walker Quarter Horses of South Dakota, Morgan intends on making another push for the NFR.

"I really think he'll do well in the big outdoor pens," she said. "We haven't really got the buildings conquered yet. He gets a little short on me. I think it's more me than him. We just need to make more runs together. I think he'll be really good next year."

Amateur

Bobbi Pradon and TB Rowdy Bug ("Rowdy") didn't have a lot futurity experience under their belts before the JB Quarter Horses Futurity.

Pradon, Odessa, Texas purchased the 4-year-old gelding, by Cosettas Rowdy out of Coal Dash Cash, by Count The Cash, last December after his breeder and trainer Todd Burger ran him in the BFA Juvenile. She ran at the LG Pro Classic in February but ended up taking an unexpected seven-month hiatus from barrel racing. She and Rowdy made their first runs back at the Lucky Dog in Texarkana before Jud Little's futurity in Ardmore. She said her runs in the JB Futurity were good. She stayed very consistent turning in a 15.900 in the qualifying round and a 16.046 in the Championship Round.

"My first run was good," she said. "My last run, he slipped on his first one, but he recovered and ran well. I was pleased." Pradon, who can generally be spotted at the barrel races with one of her pet apes in tow—in Waco she had a Gibbons ape with her—grew up riding and started competing in junior high. Her mother was most

influential in her horse knowledge.

She said she wanted to thank her husband Daniel and all her friends for their help and support.



Elite Extravaganza Surpasses Expectations

Just how well was the new two-run format accepted at the Elite Extravaganza—just ask the tired workers at the Extraco Center who set up portable stalls all weekend and the barrel racers who watched the giant warm-up pen in back shrink by a third. Barrel racers loved the new two-run option at the Elite Extravaganza, held Nov. 11-13 at the Extraco Center in Waco, Texas.

Nearly 2,000 open runs were made between the two \$35,000 GUARANTEED open races and \$10,000 GUARANTEED warm-up race. Buckles were award in each to first-place in each division, while saddles were awarded on a two-run average.

1D Champion

Clint Sherlin, a 21-year-old horseshoer from Athens, Tenn., made the 15-hour trip to Waco well worth the effort with a 1D Average Championship on Bully By Design.

The super-hot duo, which almost won the NBHA 1D World Championship a few weeks ago, finished second in Main Race 1 and won Main Race 2 for \$3,549 in total earnings.

"I was pretty tickled," Sherlin said. "I'm glad he did good, because I went 15 hours for it."

Chris Hayes, who co-owns Red with Sherlin, encouraged him to make the trip. The two have owned Red for about two years. The 6-year-old sorrel gelding is by Designer Red out of Ethel Bully, by Bully Bullion.

Next on tap for the two will be the BFA World Championship Derby.

"After that we may sell him," said Sherlin, who wanted to thank Jason Cloud of Triple Creek Saddles. "I don't really want to because he's working so good right now."

Sherlin, who has competed all over the eastern half of the United States, said the Elite barrel races was one of the fastest run events he'd ever attended.

"I'll go back next year," he said. "I'll bring some colts for the futurity. The ground was good—it held you but had some slide to it, and it was the same all weekend."

2D Champion

Bethaney Ramero of Georgetown, Texas, may have been disappointed with her runs at Waco, but she was definitely happy with the result—her second trophy saddle in two months.

"My runs this weekend were horrible," said Ramero, who won the 2011 Texas NBHA Youth 1D Championship. "I win Wrap N 3's and place at the rodeos, so I was upset."

Ramero's parents purchased Wonders Pal A Moon ("Moon Man") from Judy O'Quinn, who bought the 2005 palomino gelding by Wonders Pal out of Maudies Moon Song, by Maudies Joak, from his breeder Sybelle Dymmek of Florida.

"They bought him for me to go rodeo," said Ramero, who wanted to thank her parents, trainer Teri George, Judy O'Quinn, Sybelle Dymmek and EquiFitness. "I want to go for the Rookie of

the Year, but we're waiting to get two horses together to go for it." Ramero, a 19-year-old sophomore at Austin Community College, is in a two-year program to be a pharmacy technician. After she gets her certification, she would like to pro rodeo.

3D Champion

People always tend to notice 8-year-old Jayci Byler when she runs. The newly crowned 3D Champion is the little girl that intentionally kicks her stirrups before she runs.

"She still won't run with stirrups," says her mom, Kimmi Byler of HorseSwim in Bellville, Texas. "She'll warm with them, but she'll kick her stirrups before a run and lock her feet in front (of them). She tells me they just don't make her feel right when she runs." The talented young hand rode a veteran partner, 17-year-old Smidgen Of Honor ("Midge"), a daughter of the great Jet Of Honor out of Nola Cola, by Pacific Sailor.

"She was raised and trained by Ed and Martha (Wright)," explained Byler. "Cindy Wheeler derbied and rodeoed on her. My clients, the Winns, got her and won a lot in the TYRA (Texas Youth Rodeo Association) and YRA (Youth Rodeo Association). When they moved up in horses, Jayci was ready to move up too."

Byler said the mare still runs in same bit as she did when she left the Wrights possession. Having carried her daughter to three trophy saddles, the mare gets all the TLC she needs.

"She can still run in the 1D, but she takes care of Jayci," said Byler. "She swims five days a week, gets Adequan every three days, Dr.



Sheffield: 7

BRR: Which horse(s) did you ride all year?

Sheffield: Skip the Finances (Zoey) 7 year old bay mare

BRR: Which horse(s) are you taking with to the finals?

Sheffield: I'll take Zoey and my older mare Kat (Katmando-20 year old grey mare)

BRR: History of the horse(s) that you'll be running at the WNFR? **Sheffield:** I started on Zoey when she was 4, she got hurt in the Spring of her 5 year old year and was off for 10 months. When I started back on her the Spring of her 6 year old year she snapped right back and things just took off from there. The first part of our circuit rodeos my main horse was sore so I decided to let Zoey have the last rodeo of the weekend and she won it. I've stayed on her since and ran Kat at mostly amature rodeos and 4Ds. The first summer I had Zoey we made the short round in Reno, won the Xtreme 15 race in Salina, UT and won the 100th Pendleton Roundup. Winning Pendleton left me at 26th in the world for 2010 and opened the door for me to get into Houston in 2011. Her approximate LTE are \$120,000.

BRR: What was the high point of your 2011 season? **Sheffield:** Winning Houston! Not only was it a huge win monetarily it also allowed me to fulfill my dream of going to the NFR. I have a full time job as a Marketing Coordinator at US Foods so I rodeo as much as possible, but not year round. I call US Foods my full time job but I work a lot harder out on the road than I do at my desk so I really admire those that rodeo full time! Someday I'll rodeo full time, but it's not in the cards at the moment. After winning Houston I felt like I had fulfilled not only my NFR dream but a lot of other "average" barrel racers' dreams as well.

BRR: What training tip would you give the average competitor wanting to raise their level of competition?

Sheffield: Go out there and try. It's not easy but you can't quit. You never know what you can do until you put it all on the line. I never would have entered Pendleton without the encouragement of my husband and my Pendleton win has opened so many doors for me. Do what works for you and your horse. Not everything that works for other girls and their horses will work for you so you have to find what fits your program the best. Most of all, beleive in yourself, your horse and your faith.

BRR: If you could ride any other horse other than your own at the NFR, what other 2011 NFR horse would you ride?

Sheffield: Martha! That horse is just amazing...the way she can move her body is like nothing I've seen any other horse do.

used with Boogers Apache (an own son of Cee Booger Red) at the rodeos whenever I didn't run the roan. Firebug has made or helped make the Prairie Circuit Finals 9 years in a row including this year. Firebug made it to the NFR last year (2010) and has won around \$110k to \$120k the last two years. Firebug has battled back from both West Nile Virus and EPM and we have even had to treat him for EPM recently. His lifetime earnings are probably somewhere in the \$300-350k.

BRR: What was the high point of your 2011 season? **Anderson:** Firebug being voted 3rd in the AQHA/WPRA Horse of the Year. I grew up in the AQHA and my Dad was an AQHA judge and since the girls vote on it, it is pretty cool to think they respect Firebug enough for him to end up 3rd in the Horse Of The Year voting.

Another high point was finally winning my Circuit. In the Prairie Circuit, I have been reserve several times but things would always happen to keep me from winning it. Last year I was leading by 3k and rode a different horse because Firebug was hurt and didn't end up winning.
