One for the Record Books—Sherry Cervi Earns Fourth WPRA World Championship

“Overwhelming,” was how Sherry Cervi described her fourth WPRA World Championship. She won her first with “Troubles” in 1995 and her second came with Count Jet (“Hawk”) in 1999. Cervi and her great mare, MP Meter My Hay (“Stingray”) won their first title together in 2010 and were able to maintain her pre-Wrangler National Finals Rodeo lead throughout the 10 grueling rounds in the tiny confines of the Thomas & Mack Center.

Cervi and Stingray became the first horse and rider duo to place in every round at the WNFR since four-time World Champion Kristie Peterson and the great French Flash Hawk (“Bozo”) did in 1997.

Incidentally, Stingray’s sire PC Frenchmans Hayday—also an NFR average money earner—is a full brother to Bozo. Her dam Miss Meter Jet, by Bar Tonto Jet, is a three-quarter sister to Hawk. When asked how she left Vegas with a World title, the NFR Championship, a new 10-run average record (138.15 to Jill Moody and TR Dashing Badger’s 138.26 in 2010), the Ram Top Gun Truck for winning the most money of any contestant at the WNFR (\$155,899) and setting a new single event season’s earnings record at \$303,317, she said simply “I’ve got a really cool horse.”

They jumped out to a quick start by winning the first round. “That was really cool,” beamed Cervi. “It’s not that I didn’t think she could, but she went in there all business. She’s getting so much more solid as she gets older and it doesn’t take as many runs to get in the groove.”

With all the money up for grabs in each round, Cervi has always gone into the WNFR thinking of the rodeo as 10 one-run rodeos. Even as the rodeo progressed and it seemed as though Stingray

skimmed closer and closer to the cans, Cervi never weakened.

“I knew I needed to keep placing in the rounds,” said the 38-year-old barrel racer from Marana, Ariz. “It wasn’t like I needed to place in all 10 rounds, but I needed to go as fast as I could. Obviously, I knew I needed to stay tough in the average. It never really changed.

Bauserman Returns, Notches First \$100K Win

It’s been 15 years since Cody Bauserman won his first futurity, and there’s virtually nothing in that industry the 41-year-old trainer hasn’t won – except a \$100,000 slot race.

After taking a year away from barrels to venture into training thoroughbred racehorses, he returned Dec. 10-14 to not only win the BFA Super Stakes, but do it on his own horse with his own slot – which means keeping every last one of the \$100,000 for himself.

In a field of 50 horses all making the first competitive run of their lives, he rode his 3-year-old colt, Promise Me A Wagon, to

a time of 15.718 to edge Troy Crumrine by just .013 for the huge win.

“It happened to be real close,” Bauserman admitted. “All I try to do is make the best run possible. I’ve run at these things so many years, it’s best not to worry about what’s winning; just make your best run and let the chips fall where they fall.”

Two years ago, Bauserman had purchased Promise Me A Wagon and his embryo brother as yearlings from Stacy Charette-Hill out of her mare, Pie Sky Promises. While the yearlings’ daddy, PYC Paint

Your Wagon, is a leading sire in Quarter horse racing with a stud fee of \$15,000, Bauserman could have cared less. He bought them solely because of their dam.

"That mare is phenomenal," Bauserman said. "There's no better mare in the industry."

Pie Sky Promises had earned more than \$30,000 on her own in the barrel pen before producing superstars and being named 2004 Broodmare of the Year. Some of her legendary get include futurity standouts No Questions No Lies and Promises To Dash. And seven years ago, Alona James won the same \$100,000 Super Stakes on 3-year-old Promise Me A Title.

Charette-Hill has since sold Pie Sky Promises, now 24, to a Brazilian breeding program, but she kept a 2-year-old stallion out of her named Promise Me Pyc that's lighting up the racetrack.

As for Bauserman, he's having flashbacks to the success he had on the half-brother, Promises To Dash, who won both Speedhorses and much more in 2004.

"I called him Squirrel, and I call this one Possum," he said of Promise Me A Wagon. "He just acts real quiet like he's asleep and then all of a sudden he'll wake up and do something out of the ordinary. He's built a lot like Squirrel but is more like a rope horse with a wide front end and a big old butt like he's 10 years old. He's really mature for his age. I don't know if it looks like it yet and there are still a few things this colt is figuring out, but it sure feels like he works like Squirrel."

Possum went on to place in the first round of the juvenile futurity. His twin brother is actually faster, Bauserman said, which gets him into trouble being only 3, so he's bringing him along more slowly. The Ohio native from Sallisaw, Okla., is also running a couple of Bully Bullion colts this year.

"I'll pick and choose where I go and spend more time on the thoroughbreds now," he said. "In 2012, I needed to take a break. I needed to give my body a break; it was just beat up. I did it for my own self. I needed barrel racing to be fun again."

Nothing's more fun than winning \$100,000, but Bauserman still said his primary emotion was relief more than excitement.

"Pretty much all I had left to do in barrel racing is win one of these \$100,000 races," he said. "It's been a long journey trying to get one. You even wear yourself out. Doing this on my own horse with my own money all by myself is more exciting than actually winning the \$100,000. I did it on my own."

While Bauserman is the first to admit barrel racing has been very good to him, he is simply more into claiming and training racehorses now.

"I'll run barrels the rest of my days," he said. "I just want to do it on my own terms."

As the week went on more things came on the line if I kept placing, kept winning money I knew I had a chance to win the truck. I wanted to keep doing well in the average because that was really important for me to win."

The barrel racers were allowed practice time in the Thomas & Mack every other day, but other than a cruise through in the first round, Cervi just walked through each time.

"I would just walk her, nothing more than that," said Cervi, who wanted to thank her family, friends and sponsors for all their help and support. "It was way more for me than her. It was habit. They give you the opportunity to get in there and I figured I'd better take advantage of it."

Rather than give Stingray—who was voted Horse With The Most Heart by the Top 15 barrel racers—more room, Cervi focused on riding Stingray correctly.

"When you start to safety up you start making mistakes and I didn't want to safety up," she explained. "There is so much money to be won in the rounds, but I didn't want to do anything stupid and mess my average up. I wasn't trying to safety up by any means."

She said the 10th round was the tensest by far.

"I kept myself from thinking about anything but going around the barrels, getting around them. I didn't know if I had the world championship won or not because I wouldn't let anybody around me talk about it. I wanted to win the average and I knew that I needed to keep winning money. I knew I was at the top, but I didn't know how far at the top I was. I didn't look at any of it, but I knew there was a lot on the line. There was a lot on the line with that

run."

Stingray, 11, ran at approximately 50 of the 60-something rodeos that Cervi competed at during the 2013 season. She also won money MP A Man With Roses until he was sidelined for most of the year with an injury and Reality Go ("Easy"), who belongs to Trip and Callie duPerier (they also own Shes Free To Flame who ran at the WNFR with Brittany Pozzi).

Cervi will stick to her annual game plan by starting off the year with all the futurities in Buckeye, Ariz.

"I'm not as ready as I should be but they're nice colts. Usually I can get them ready by the end of their 5-year-old year," she laughed.

Her rodeo season will start with the winter run in Texas.

"I'm going to go to the same rodeos as I always do in the winter. I like those rodeos down in Texas. Then in April I don't do much rodeoing and I put on my barrel race (the Sherry Cervi West Coast Youth Championships held with the Spring Run Classic in Ceres, Calif.), May, I'll go to some of my circuit rodeos and then in June I'll take off for the summer. I love rodeoing in the summer."

Montgomery Repeats Juvie Title, Wins \$133K+

What Jolene Montgomery loves more than anything is competing on 3-year-olds.

"I had great 4-year-olds this year; they were great all year," said Montgomery, who earned \$48,647 (including Future Fortunes Money) in Oklahoma City the week of Dec. 10-14 on 4-year-olds Hesa Dashing Dreamer and Martha's Sixshooter. "But I really love the juvenile futurity. It's exciting; you don't really have huge expectations because it's their first competitive run ever. You're not mad at them if they don't perform, but it's icing on the cake if they do."

For the second straight year, one of her 3-year-olds performed its way to the Juvenile Futurity Championship. In fact, the two 3-year-old fillies she trained not only dominated the Juvenile Futurity, but took second and third in the Super Stakes, too.

When it's time to decide which 3-year-old to run in the slot race (a rider can run only one), Montgomery always chooses the most solid, quiet-minded of her mounts. So she stuck with Dale Rankin's filly, Streakin Easily by his stallion Dashin Is Easy. In the meantime, the owner of Dashin Czar – Matt Dunn – also had a slot open.

Just before the deadline, the Tres Seis daughter started out-clocking everything, so Montgomery told him he'd better find a rider for her.

With Troy Crumrine aboard, the filly posted a 15.7 to come within .013 of a second of that \$100,000 first-place prize in the Super Stakes. Instead, she earned \$35,000 for second. Then Montgomery placed Streakin Easily right on Crumrine's tail with a 15.8 for third and \$23,000. It was a great way to kick things off with both fillies, and she wasn't done yet.

Last year, Montgomery won the juvie on Martha's Sixshooter with a 31.338 on two runs. This year, she bested that with a 31.254 on Dashin Czar winning \$17,475 altogether, then took second,

too, aboard Streakin Easily, winning a total of \$14,652. Including the slot money, Montgomery's trainees crossed the finish line for a combined \$90,125 for owners Matt Dunn and Dale Rankin – plus another \$25,000 in Future Fortunes cash (Montgomery also placed in rounds on two other 3-year-olds).

In the first round of the Juvenile Futurity, Montgomery took first on Streakin Easily with a 15.6 and fourth on Kimi Nichols' KN Fa-

mous Czar. Then in round two, she clocked a 15.3 on Dashin Czar to win the round by an unbelievable four-tenths of a second.

She calls Dashin Czar "Tracy" around the barn ("I wasn't feeling real original with the nicknames this year," she cracked), and has been riding her since about March. Matt Dunn bought the filly at the Heritage Place sale off the track, where she had several outs but hadn't made any big splashes. After she spent 45 days getting broke, Montgomery took the reins.

"She's very, very confident," Montgomery said. "She's probably still a little green yet, so she had no tricks at all. She just runs hard and straight until you ask her to turn. So you have to be right there with her, because if you make a mistake, she'll do just what you asked her to do."

Montgomery didn't get a chance to work Tracy after Crumrine ran her in the Super Stakes, and the next morning for the juvie, the two didn't quite have their timing in the first round. But after a tune-up and a Troy Brandenburg stretching session, the filly felt awesome and Montgomery got her feel back – that's when they won the second round by almost a half-second.

"I was also really confident in the other mare," Montgomery said. "She smoked the first barrel like an open horse and the crowd went nuts and I got a little excited and pushed her a little too hard so she pushed through second and third."

Part of the reason Montgomery's 3-year-olds have excelled this year, she says, is the fact that the Texas weather was so bad all fall. Without an indoor pen, she ended up hauling the heck out of the 3-year-olds just to work them in decent ground.

"They've been everywhere, because I could do nothing at home except ride them in the pasture," she said.

The winnings will help Montgomery pay off a few things around the house where she and her husband, Kerby, have lived now for three years. Montgomery – who gives credit to sponsors Classic Equine, RazerHorse Shoes and Priefert – rode a total of 12 different horses in Oklahoma City including her two biggest winners, Dashin Czar and Streakin Easily. At home, she works up to 15 a day with the help of Kerby, his sister Molli Montgomery, and three other gals who help out in various ways.

"I'm really pumped about this year's colts," said Montgomery. "It always scares you, having them ready this fast. But I do my best not to let any of them blow up. They're just too nice to push them too hard."

All told, including Future Fortunes money and 2D placings here and there, Montgomery herself spurred her way to \$23,000 in the

slot race, \$61,184 in the juvenile futurity and \$49,292 in the futurity to make \$133,436 for the owners of her colts in Oklahoma City.

Rios Continues Streak With BFA Futurity Win

A little over a month after winning the Futurity at the WPR World Finals, Callie Rios and Blazing Baby J won the Futurity at the prestigious BFA World Championships in Oklahoma City, Dec. 10-14.

It was a bittersweet weekend, as many of the finalists in the Futurity and Derby wore pink shirts depicting angel wings in a touching tribute to the late Megan Stockstill and Boe Kellogg, who each passed away in 2013.

Rios hit a barrel in the first round on the 4-year-old son of Dash Ta Fame that she trained before selling to Angela Ganter. But it's the 50 fastest times from the collective rounds that come back to the finals, and her next run of 15.299 placed second in the second round by just a half-tenth behind Jolene Montgomery on Hesa Dashing Dreamer.

Then in the finals, Rios smoked a 15.214. It wasn't the fastest of the round – that honor went to Kassie Mowry aboard Powder Girls Shakem – but it was second-fastest and enough to give her the average title on two by one-tenth over Erin Ricotti on Famous Scarlett. Rios earned \$47,575 for Ganter aboard her favorite horse.

"I wasn't even paying attention to the times or anything," she said. "I was just worried about going in and making a smooth run. I actually tipped second and it started falling and came back up, so it was a real close call."

Blazin Baby J is not a horse that hits barrels, she said, so if she hits one it's always because she simply wasn't going fast enough. "In the first round I just hadn't sent him in there hard enough to it," she said. "In the finals, I knew if I just left the barrels up, we'd be fine."

Ganters will keep the horse with Rios this winter so she can season him to rodeos as he turns 5. She plans to enter the first one in Odessa and go on from there.

"I think he'll handle it fine," she said. "I took him to a couple of amateur rodeos last year and he was fine. It'll be something different for me and lots of fun."

All 50 entries in the Futurity finals got paid at least \$900, with the whopping first-place paycheck still coming in at \$43,884. A lot of the prize money went to Kassie Mowry, who competed on eight futurity horses and placed three in the top 12. She was fifth on Kristan Crain's Powder Girls Shakem, eighth on Dave and Lori Zabel's My Guy Can Fly, 11th on Peggy Fenton's Eye Speak French and 24th on Charlie Cole & Jason Martin's Tax The Frenchman.

Regan Henning's 4-year-old mare Story Tellin Daisy was the year-end Futurity Champion. Henning, by the way, was in the junior division last year. The mare is by The Money Doctor (by On The Money Red crossed on a Bully Bullion daughter) and out of Story Tellen Flower (by an Impressive grandson crossed on a Go Man Go granddaughter).

Meanwhile, at the World Championships, Elizabeth Michael

took top honors of all Amateurs, posting a 15.714 on her final run aboard Honor Annies Fame to earn \$1,320.

And in the Open 4D at Oklahoma City, a teenaged boy and a 70-year-old woman beat the pants off the entire crowd. The first Open race was won by young Max Chouest by two-tenths of a second on VF A Sporty Design for \$1,995. And the second round – in a blistering 15.212 – went to June Holeman on Hope's Money Boy for her own \$1,995 (Chouest placed sixth for another \$840).

And Chouest matched his 15.3 from the Open with another 15.3 to win the Junior 4D race at the World Championships on VF A Sporty Design. That was worth another \$1,090. It was a tough race with entries that included the likes of Sydney Surin (who has qualified for the American), Ivy Conrado, Jackie Ganter, Kylar Terlip, and his own sister, Allie Chouest.

Scarlett's Babies Hot in OKC for Haislips

The biggest buzz coming out of the BFA World Championships isn't usually surrounding the derby.

But that all changed on Dec. 10-14 when a jockey who had never been to Oklahoma City in her life broke one of the most prestigious arena records in the country on a 6-year-old son of NFR mare Go Royal Scarlett.

"I knew as soon as I turned the first barrel," said Erin Ricotta, whom Ruth and Jim Haislip tapped to run Royal Star Commander at the BFA Derby. "I didn't know what the record was, but I knew he'd win the round. When he makes that hard move; he plants that hind leg deep and just comes back so hard. It's a real fast style."

The unbelievable 14.847 smashed the old record (14.881, JL Dash Ta Heaven, rider Ashley Nelson Schafer, owner Jud Little, BBR Wolrd Finals 2011) and won the second round by three-tenths of a second. They'd clocked a 15.9 in the first round, which was won with a 15.3 by Jackie Ganter on Bobbie Gene – the 2013 year-end BFA Derby Champion.

"On the first run, he was running very free and was kind of overwhelmed with everything going on," Ricotta said of Commander. "He likes to look around. I took him to the practice arena and set him down a couple of times at first; basically reassured him that I'm up here and let me help you. Don't try to do it all on your own."

Then, in the finals, it was young Allie Chouest on RLJ High Intedsity who clocked a 15.2 for the win. Ricotti managed a 15.6, which was just enough to give her the average championship over Andrea Cline and Stitches Streaknfame. The Amateur champion in the Derby was Mary Beth Ogle on RLJ Czech This Out with a 15.603, which paid her \$1,650.

The Derby average was extremely tight, with less than three-tenths of a second separating the top six. Ricotta earned \$10,619

"I think he was just born to do it," Ricotta said. "He was started by Jim Haislip and Rachael Myllymaki, who is really good at getting a horse to fire off a turn whenever I've seen her run anything. Those two deserve a ton of credit."

Myllymaki had other commitments during the World Championships, Dec. 10-14, so Haislips asked Ricotta, who lives about 45

minutes away from their Acampo home, to haul the horses more than 30 hours to Oklahoma City.

"There'd have been all kinds of world records if Rachael had run these horses," cracked Ricotta, a longtime Hollywood stuntwoman who has ridden colts all her life.

Ruth Haislip, a small-animal vet, had flown to Oklahoma City, and was ecstatic to watch her two young horses out of Scarlett not only win the derby, but also win second in the futurity. On Famous Scarlett ("Jewel"), a 4-year-old daughter by Dash Ta Fame that ran in her dam's old D-ring snaffle, Ricotta had posted runs of 15.3 and 15.2 to nail the reserve championship and \$32,887. That brought her total haul from Oklahoma City to \$43,506.

Haislip had also raised Go Royal Scarlett. Now 21, the mare earned nearly a half-million dollars and took Haislip to three NFRs and nine California Circuit Finals rodeos. She was by a stallion that went back to Clabber and War Admiral and out of a granddaughter of Three Oh's and Clabber.

Jewel is by Dash Ta Fame, while Commander, the 6-year-old, is by a stallion that Haislips partnered on with Marilyn Camarillo for a time. AR Star is a stakes-winning son of Shawne Bug out of a Go Man Go granddaughter. On both sides, his pedigree boasts the thoroughbred stallion Direct Win – who can also be found in the lineage of both Dash For Cash and Streakin Six.

"When Jim brought those two horses over to me to ride a week or so before Oklahoma City, I just started laughing and smiling," Ricotta said. "They're so easy. They just want to turn barrels. Commander is very athletic and fast, and Jewel, she just wants to turn. I have watched her loose in the arena, and if the barrels are up, she'll turn one like she would in a run. Not a half turn – all the way around it. With Commander, it's just about getting him to slow down enough to turn. I don't even think he knows how fast he's going."

Ricotta's mentor has always been 7-time NFR barrel racer Mari-

lyn Camarillo, with whom she lived while training horses at the age of 16. Since Camarillo and Haislip go way back, she's also known the Haislips for decades.

Ricotta, 50, has doubled for Jennifer Love Hewitt (in the I Know What You Did Last Summer films), Sarah Michelle Gellar, Ann Margaret and more. Today, her daughter is starting a stunt career in the motion picture industry and one son is a PBR bull rider, while the other is 14 and lives at home. Her kids were excited, but nothing like what Ruth Haislip was feeling.

"Ruth was already over the moon with me placing on Jewel because Jewel reminds her so much of Scarlett," Ricotta said. "Then Commander broke the record. We almost double championed the two horses.

"But that would have been way too much," she cracked. "The universe would have tilted."

2013 National Finals Facts & Figures

- Sherry Cervi won her 4th World Title (1995, 1999, 2010, 2013), her second (2010, 2013) on Stingray (Mp Meter My Hay).
- A barrel racer won the Ram Top Gun award for the most money won at the WNFR for the second year in a row; Sherry Cervi this year and Mary Walker last year.
- Cervi earned \$155,899 at the 2013 WNFR to set the All-Time WNFR earnings record for a single event. Mary Walker previously held the record, when she earned 146,941 at the 2012 WNFR.
- Cervi also became the 5th person to place in all 10 rounds. She joins; Colette Graves Baier 1974, Lynn McKenzie 1978, Charmayne James 1986, Kristie Peterson 1996-1997. 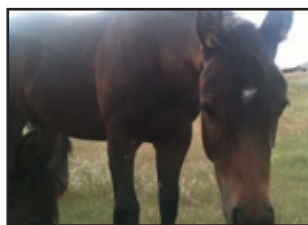
