Pedone & Solid Red Socks Capture Greg Olson Slot Race

Veteran futurity rider and trainer Ryann Pedone, Decatur, Texas, found herself back in the winner's circle with Shoppa Ranch's Solid Red Socks ("Welma"). The duo topped the Greg Olson Memorial Futurity Slot Race with a 17.134 on a WPRA Standard Pattern for \$20,000.

"She's just a really cool little mare," Pedone said of the 5-year-old mare. "She was last on the ground at 150. She lost her footing a little at her second barrel and she really just gritted up. When she turned the third barrel, I picked up my whip and went to hustling her home. I knew it was going to be fast, but I didn't think it would be that fast on the bottom of the ground."

Of the six futurity horses Pedone has for 2015, she has raised four of them including Welma. The daughter of BHR Frenchies Socks is out of Pedone's former barrel horse Red Flashin Money, by On The Money Red. Incidentally, while Welma was wining the slot race in Arizona, Red Flashin Money was winning a youth rodeo in Texas with Jayci Byler.

"She's just a really gritty, kind, all-business, non-clingy, non-emotional," Pedone said of Welma. "If you're going to war, she's the sniper you want to have behind you. She's a really cool little mare with a big heart. She has a little bit of that On The Money Red look to her, but she has a prettier head. When you look at her, she wouldn't be the one you'd pick. She's cute as a button, but you wouldn't look at her and say she's got a big motor."

The mare was one of her favorite 3-year-olds and was pointed to the 2014 futurities until she nearly died from a neurologic illness in October 2013.

"Whatever it was, it was really severe," said Pedone. "She was dog-sitting, couldn't walk. They thought she was going to die."

Dr. Justin Gardner, who was interning at Outlaw Equine at the time, was charged with treating the mare. "He spent a lot of time with her and genuinely cared," said Pedone. "She was a pain to treat too." Pedone also enlisted the help of Dr. Peggy Fleming, a holistic veterinarian from Florida, who sent a remedy for the mare.

By March 2014, Welma was strong enough to return to training. Rather than try to salvage her 4-year-old campaign, the Shoppas and Pedone decided to hold her to the 5-year-old futurities.

"When I got back on her," said Pedone, "she worked really cute, but I didn't know if that ordeal was going to take a little bit out of her. I had her entered in the BFA, but I really didn't spend a lot of time on her because I was concentrating on my 3-year-olds."

Welma ended up a tenth or two out of making the cutoff for the Futurity Finals on her first two competitive runs in Oklahoma City. At the first futurity in Arizona, Welma proved she could shut the clock off. "I didn't give her enough credit on her comeback," said Pedone.



Barrel Racers FAQ's for American Semi-Finals The Patriot - RFD-TV's The American Rodeo

January will see the end of the qualification season for the 2015 American Rodeo, and with that everyone from contestants to producers are focusing on the last three legs of the competition.

Stalls - Will Rogers Memorial Center & Sports Complex, Ft. Worth, TX Stalls are available beginning Tuesday, February 17th at Will Rogers Memorial Center & Sports Complex in Ft. Worth, TX Semi-Finalists will be stalled in Barn 3 and Barn 4 in the dirt floored stalls. Stalls can be purchased for just the Semi-Finals, or until the morning following the American Rodeo (Feb 17-March 2).

Feb 17-Feb 22: \$125 (Semi-Finals), Feb 23-March 2: \$150 (Patriot), Feb 17-March 2: \$200 (All Three events Semi-Finals, Patriot, American Rodeo)

American Rodeo Semi-Finals - CowTown Coliseum, Ft. Worth, TX Exemption Contestants: \$500 Entry Fee due February 1st. Exemption contestants from the BBR World Finals, the High School National Finals Champion, the College National Finals Champion, the Indian National Finals Champion and the Pikes Peak Or Bust Rodeo Champion, all need to pay their entry fees to compete at the American Semi-Finals. Check-Ìn & Open Arena Ride Time: Contestant online Registration forms are due Thursday, February 5th. Contestant Check in will take place Tuesday, February 17th, from 4pm-7pm, in the Longhorn Room at the Stockyards Hotel, Ft. Worth, TX. Barrel racers' open ride time is from 6pm-8pm. The second check-in is Wednesday morning from 6am-8am before slack starts for anyone who was unable to come in on Tuesday.

Contestant Tickets: Contestants will each receive 2 tickets to the slack performance for the event they are competing in. Short Go qualifiers will receive two tickets to the performance they are drawn to compete in.

Barrel Slack: Wednesday, February 18th, 9am, Cowtown Coliseum. Slack will be run by random draw and will include all 110 qualifiers plus exemption contestants. The fastest 30 times from the slack round will move on to the Short Go,

Short Go Rodeo Perfs: The short go will consist of three rodeo perfs, one Friday night at 7pm, one Saturday night at 7pm, and one Sunday at 2pm. Contestants will be drawn for perfs with 10 competing in each perf. The fastest 10 times from the three perfs will proceed to The American Rodeo, where they will go head to head with Top 10 from WNFR.

American Rodeo Sponsor Patch Auction

This year, after the conclusion of the Semi-Finals on February 22, RFD-TV is asking all athletes who will be competing in The American Rodeo to come to Billy Bob's at 7pm for the 2015 Sponsor Patch Auction. 

Semas Rides Three of the Top 4 at the Greg Olson

Her peers have taken to calling the 2015 Greg Olson Memorial Futurity in Buckeye, Ariz., the Tami Semas clinic. The barrel racer from Prineville, Oregon, won the Futurity with Guys Best Bet ("Bet"), owned by Harry LaToush, Scott City, Kanas, placed third and fourth with her two personal horses—Smooth N Famous and Guys Amberetto, respectively.

"I'm really happy with my horses worked and how consistent they were," said Semas. "I'm really thankful to be riding such nice

Semas' total earnings for the Futurity were \$23,445. Bet's share was \$8,349, while fourth-place finisher Guys Amberetto was the high-money earner with \$10,048, thanks to a fourth-place finish in

Her futurity champion was bred by Bill and Deb Myers and purchased by LaToush at their 2013 Production Sale for \$56,000. Bet is by the legendary Frenchmans Guy out of Addicted To Cash, a full sister to leading barrel horse sire Dash For Perks. Addicted To Cash is by Dash For Cash out of the Easy Jet mare Perks. Incidentally, Bet's full sister via embryo transfer, Set Me Free Guys, also placed eighth in the Greg Olson Futurity with Nikki Steffes.

"She ran really nice and smooth," Semas said of Bet. "She has a really smooth style. She does things pretty easily, effortlessly. Real quiet. She ran a 17.3 the first day and I was really happy with it. She came back and ran a 17.1 and I was just tickled with it. I was just really happy with her."

Her third-place finisher Smooth N Famous ("Perkins"), a 4-yearold gelding by A Smooth Guy out of FC Peachfuzz Ta Fame, by Dash Ta Fame, was an \$18,500 purchase as a 2-year-old from the 2013 Myers Sale.

"I have to thank all my family and friends, who continued to support me, after having such a rough year last year," said Pedone. She also want to give a special thank you to Alan and Wendy Parker, who started her on this barrel racing journey so long ago. One of the highlights of her dismal 2014 was getting to spend the Mega Race in Jackson, Miss., with the Parkers shortly before Wendy Parker passed away.

"He's not a very big horse," said Semas. "He has just been so consistent. He placed last weekend at the Classic Equine (Futurity), fifth in the average, fourth in the first round. I came back on him this weekend and placed in both rounds and placed third in the average. He's really gritty and tries really hard. He's got a cool style.

He's also really quiet. Just loves his job."

Perkins earned \$5,048.

Semas' fourth-place finisher Guys Amberetto was purchased from the Myers. Amber is a 4-year-old Frenchmans Guy out of Amber Holland, by Holland Ease.

"The first futurity, I tipped my first barrel leaving it to run a 17.1 on her and I was just really excited. I knew it was there," noted Semas. "The first go round of a Greg Olson, she ran a 17.2 and placed second and placed in the slot race with that .2. My second run I had a little trouble with my second barrel and we were a 17.5."

Ironically, the only horse that seemed to have trouble at the first futurity was Bet, which surprised Semas because the mare had been doing the best of her trio.

"We stumbled the first day and didn't clock," she said. "The second day, I hit the second barrel. I had an off weekend on her, but I knew what I had to dial in on her when I came back for the Greg Olson."

Semas, the mother of two middle-school children with husband Aaron, a former bull rider and founding member of the PBR, started dabbling with futurity colts seriously about six years ago.

"Over the last five or six years, I've had colts, but I've had some unfortunate luck," she said. "I had some colts die on me. I've had things go wrong. I had two colts last year—one that I owned and one I got in the middle of the year. I sold my open horse last year, and I really focused on my colts for this year. I just keep trying to build my 2-year-olds, so I have colts for next year. I really like to train them myself."

The foundation of her program lies with the renowned breeding program of Bill and Deb Myers in St. Onge, S.D.

"I buy all my colts from Bill and Deb Myers so I owe them a lot," said Semas, who has won with Hot Colours, Frenchmans Guy and A Smooth Guy offspring. "Bill's such a horseman. They know their horses. I've gotten comfortable with their program. I really, really like their horses."

With a trio of nice futurity horses, Semas won't return to Oregon anytime soon. She's currently contemplating at trip the LG Pro Classic in Kinder, La., for the \$100,000 slot race, which for the first time will allow contestants to name horses at the race.

"I was originally thinking about going to the Patriot Futurity (in Fort Worth) and (the Lucky Dog Futurity in) Texarkana before Diamonds & Dirt, but people have been talking to me about the slot race at Lance's, so I may have to re-route my travel plans," she said.







Jill Lane's JL Antares Shines Brightly in BRN4D's Run 4 Platinum Coach

Jill Lane's JL Antares was the brightest star of Mike Gammelgard's BRN4D-produced futurities in Arizona. Lane, Fort Benton, Mont., and her 4-year-old mare had the fastest four-run aggregate from the Classic Equine and Greg Olson futurities to win Platinum Coach two-horse bumper-pull trailer, valued at \$18,625.

"Kathy Grimes had text me 'Congrats, I think you won the trailer," chuckled Lane. "I was getting a horse reset at the time, and text back, 'Don't even say that unless you know for sure!' Another friend text me and said she knew; she had seen the results. I almost started crying. I had never won anything like that!"

As excited as she was, Lane was quick to add, "That was a pretty generous donation—for Platinum Coach to do that. It's great that they have companies like that that will support the barrel racing industry. I can't thank them enough."

Lane's homebred mare, appropriately named after the a red supergiant that is the 17th brightest star in the night sky by Lane's friend and web designer Kitty Herron, is a 4-year-old bay daughter of Red, Lane's NFR siring Thoroughbred. She is out of Delta Doc Star, a daughter of Runnerelse out of Koak, by Doc's Oak.

After growing up just five miles from Jeani Reiman and her great Magnolia Bar son Runnerelse, Lane always dreamed of having one of her own. She met Reiman at a barrel futurity in Belle Fourche, S.D., and ended up taking 2-year-old Delta Doc Star home.

"Delta was one of the first futurity horses that I trained," recalled Lane. "I had been out of horses for 10 years. Everyone could see that she was really talented, but that I was green. I hadn't trained very many colts and I made a lot of mistakes with her. I think anybody that's trained a lot of horses thinks back to the first few horses that they trained and thinks 'if I could just get a do-over,' the things that you would do differently. All I can say is that Antares is so like her dam, it's like God gave me a do-over for Delta. She acts just like

her. She moves just like her. She looks just like her. They're identical at that age. It's crazy how they're so similar. I get a chance to not make the same mistakes that I made with Delta."

Antares proved to be a very quick study in the arena.

"When she was 2 and loping the pattern, she was getting bored, so I thought I'd just push her through," Lane remembered. "She laid down a run, and I was just shaking when she was done because I knew what I had...even back then. I was just praying that I

wouldn't screw it up by the time I got to her futurity year. She just came on so fast. It really didn't take that much to show her what to do, she just knew it. I think the good ones are like that. They just want to do it."

Lane took the gamble and entered Antares in the BFA Juvenile, where she made the first competitive runs of her career.

"I hadn't made any runs on her other than time onlies, so our timing was off and her confidence wasn't there. I basically rode her once between Oklahoma City and Arizona. When I came down here my goal was to make smooth runs and keep the barrels up, because I was hitting barrels left and right at Oklahoma City."

At the Classic Equine Futurity, Lane and Antares found their bearings. They clocked a 17.682 and a 17.875, which finished near the top of the heap, but not good enough for an average check.

"The first go round, it was a beautiful run, but she just wasn't running," Lane explained. "I felt the clock ticking at every barrel. She wasn't snappy on the back side. It was pretty; you couldn't fault it, but I knew it wasn't as fast as she could go. The second go, I figured I needed to ride her harder. Well my adrenalin got up. I was kicking her way too much and way too hard, and I whipped her home. It wasn't pretty. She didn't finish her turns, and the clock reflected that."

For the Greg Olson, Lane backed off and let Antares work.

"When I was warming up I was talking to Ashley Schafer," she said. "We were talking about her A Streak Of Fling and another horse that she was riding. She said I just have to sit there and stay calm because they can feel me getting nervous. I thought about that a lot. That's my whole problem, I don't think I'm that great of jockey because I let my nerves get to me. I train too many colts and I don't make enough fast competitive runs, so my timing is not there. I try to hard and then I get in their way. I thought I've just got to stay calm. My mare's a little hot and she was starting to get a little hyper at the gate. I thought I just want to make a smooth run and not hit a barrel.

"She got by her first a little bit, but she's so athletic she can be out of position one jump and then be right back in position the next. That was just the way her mother was too. We made up all our time on second. She's just like a little deer. She's in and out of there so quick. I didn't think we were going to win anything and then after we turned second I was like 'oh this feels good!' It clocked. It was a .3 and I was happy with it. I would have been happy to get that time for the second go too and not ever have to make it—just be done with it! She found her gears. I guess that was the one good thing about the second go of the first futurity when I whipped her, she did find her gears. She was running a lot harder.

"The second go she got by her first again because she was running so hard, but the rest of the run was just like her first run. She's staying consistent. I'll be thrilled if we could stay like that!"

Their runs of 17.320 and 17.407 were good enough for second in the average and \$5,436, plus the Run 4 Platinum Coach trailer.

"Everyone says I rode her well...she just makes me look good," Lane laughed. "You just get one of those that rises to the top and runs in spite of everything...that's her. It's so easy for her. I can't give her enough credit."

Lane grew up in O'Neill, Nebraska and attended the University of Nebraska in Lincoln as an agricultural business major. Right after graduation, she got a position with Merck's animal division and sold Ivomec. One of the requirements for the job was that she move to Great Falls, Mont.

"I didn't know a soul, but I knew I had to get a job, so I moved to Montana," she said. "Sixteen years later, I had 15 to 20 horses. By this time I had switched to the human health division, and I couldn't do both. I was either going to have to sell the horses and focus on my career or I was going to have to take the plunge and get into the horses. So, I took the plunge. I wouldn't say it's as lucrative as my job was, but as I've said before even on my worst day it's what I love to do. A lot of people don't get to pursue their passion like that so I feel pretty fortunate."

Each year, Lane had tried to keep a futurity prospect or two—usually a mare that would return to her broodmare band, but for one reason or another Lane hasn't got to run as much until Antares came along.

"I've never had one that I thought was ready to go to Arizona," she said. "I'm usually foaling by January so I can't go, but this year everything just fell into place. This filly really came on and I don't have any mares due until March. I just thought if there ever was the opportunity for me to go to Arizona and maybe get something done it was this year."

Lane hadn't really even thought of her Arizona trip beyond paying her filly into the futurities. In fact, she didn't even find a place to stay until the week before she left.

"I'm staying with Bobbi June Radford from Canada," she laughed. "It was really nice of her to let me come and stay."

Now, Lane has to figure out how to get her new trailer home and what to do with her talented mare while breeding and foaling season takes over her life this spring.

"I've been visiting with Sam Flannery," she said. "Sam has a slot for Diamonds & Dirt. We were just going to see how she worked at these three futurities and if she did well, I'd see about sending her to Sam to take to that futurity to run. I'm going to try to stay here another two weeks, but I have 50 head of horses at home and I'm due to start foaling in March and I won't be able to go anywhere for a while. I have 18 mares to foal and they're due mostly in April and May. Plus I want to do some embryo transfers and I have studs to stand."

In all honesty, Lane admitted she's "kind of flying by the seat of my pants this year," but she's grateful to have a product of her breeding program do so well in such tough company.

"I was sitting there watching, and they're running 17.1s, 17.2 and 17.3, and I'm thinking Holy God, what am I doing here!" she laughed. "Every year it seems like it gets tougher. Trainers are getting better, and we're breeding better horses. It's definitely being reflected in the number of tough horses out there and the times they're running. I feel honored that I even placed."

Sassy J Fame had some great runs at the barrel race but 5 days after the barrel race and one week prior to the circuit finals, she coliced and we sadly lost her 15 minutes after they performed colic surgery. The next week, Tweety made that bad all not that bad when we had a great weekend at the circuit finals," explained Wright.

Tweety and Wright went into the first round of circuit finals and although they had a couple mistakes, they still ended up winning the round. The second round went much better and they ended up taking two tenths of a second off of their time from the first round and won second in the round. The final round, Tweety was on fire and they won the round again but by this time they won the round by four tenths of a second.

"Tweety just got stronger each and every run. Her strong performance gave us enough to catch Lindsey Kruse's lead to win the year end as well as the average. I should also add that Lindsey was unable to ride at the circuit finals due to adding to their incredibly beautiful family next month so we may have gotten lucky!"

Wright explained that it is very exciting to have her horses feeling so





Seasoning Nic to rodeos his 4 year old year to now, is so crazy to think how far him and I have come along as a team. I can count on one hand how many barrels he has hit in his career. He has the best style and makes the same run every single time."

Pottmeyer and Nic ended up second in the first and second round of the finals.

"Going into the third round, we were figuring numbers and realized that we just had to make a clean run and get a check to win the year end title. I let my nerves get the best of me and over rode at every barrel but was so happy that we still ended up with an average check that kept me in there to win the year end," Pottmeyer said. Now that reality has sunk in and Pottmeyer and Nic will be making the trek to Florida, she couldn't be more excited.

Buffalo, New York barrel racer, Sarah Attea, and her trusty steed, 19 year old gelding Dash N Sparks by Dash for Perks, will be headed to their second Ram National Circuit Finals but first time to Florida!

Attea and "Sparky" as she affectionately calls Dash N Sparks, were this years' First Frontier Circuit Finals Average Champions.

"After I had found we had won the average, I cried, for several reasons. Attea explained that going into the finals, she knew getting the year end title would be difficult, as fellow circuit barrel racer Alicia Pottmeyer had a \$3,000 lead over her and Sparky. Attea knew that if there was any chance of her and Sparky making the trek to Florida, she knew it was going to have to come down to the average.

"The ground in the first round historically has been known to be hard and we were third out. winning the round.

"After our first two runs, I knew that I needed to do a few things differently before the third round in order to stay clean. I spoke with Kendal Owen and Brandon Cullins about my runs and changes that needed to be made for the third go round. 
