Anzick is Scooten Ta Victory

When the Livingston, Montana cowgirl and former NFR qualifier, Shelly Anzick loaded up her main mount for this year in the trailer and headed south, she knew she had something special riding in her trailer and it didn't take long for her to share that news with the rest of the pro rodeo world. Now, after winning the prestigious Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo, she and her big brown gelding can add another win to their impressive resume.

Anzick and 9-year-old Scooten Ta Fame (Dash Ta Fame x The Buzz Machine, by Kipadeucy), also known as Scooter, who is owned by Tommy and Shirley Martin, Oregon, and Dr. Carl Conroy, Washington, have started 2014 off with a bang. After winning the Montana Circuit Finals back in January and being crowned the Ram Montana Circuit Champion along with Montana Circuit Horse of the Year, Anzick and Scooter made their way south to the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show held January 24-February 8 in Fort Worth, Texas.

"Our first run at Fort Worth was not very good. He wasn't focused and I didn't get a good start going to the first barrel. I think he was a bit nervous running into that big coliseum, but we still

made the progressive round so we had a chance to come back and redeem ourselves," said Anzick.

Anzick finished in the top 40 in the first round with a time of 14.93 and she and Scooter were coming back to the second round with a new game plan and a positive attitude.

"Our run in the progressive round was much better. He was absolutely flawless and set the arena on fire. I was tickled with him!" Anzick and Scooter stopped the clock in

16.41 seconds, the fastest time of the rodeo thus far. With a good run under their belt, she and Scooter had to wait out a few more performances to see if their time of 16.41 would hold and if they would come back to the short round.

"I knew we had a great run but I wasn't sure if it would hold or not. It was a bit nerve-wracking but no matter what happened, I was still so proud of him."

Anzick, who had only been running Scooter for a year, spent 2013 seasoning the former stallion before deciding they were ready to go play with the wolves.

After the final run of the progressive round was ran, Anzick heard the great news. Not only did she and Scooter make the short round, but their time of 16.41 won the second round, good enough for a \$4,667 paycheck. Shelly Morgan came in a close second with a time of 16.53 for \$4,001 and Danyelle Bassett, who was leading the average going into the short round, finished third in round 2 with a time of 16.56, good enough for \$3,334.

With the short round running slowest to fastest and a hand rake by the committee following each barrel racer, the top 12 girls had only 4 tenths of a second separating them.

Anzick and Scooter blazed through the Will Rogers Memorial FWSSR Continued on Page 4

Melby Wins \$5,000 Jerry Ann Taylor Best Dressed Award by Johna Cravens for the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo

Jane Melby of Burneyville, Okla., won the \$5,000 Jerry Ann Taylor Best Dressed Award at the final championship round at the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo on Saturday, February 8.

The Women's Professional Rodeo Association and the National Cowgirl Museum and Hall of Fame present the award. Jerry Ann Taylor, a 1986 honoree of the hall, was a flamboyant trick rider and roper who was known for her sense of style.

Melby, who also qualified for Fort Worth's championship round last year, said she realized then that the judges for the award were looking for something that catches the audience's eye.

The National Finals Rodeo (NFR) barrel racer partnered with last year's winner of the Jerry Ann Taylor award, Kendra Dickson, for her winning look.

"When I left (after my second round run), I was second in the

average and Kendra was tenth. I saw her and said 'if you don't make it back (to the championship round), would you be willing to dress me and we'll split the award if I win."

Dickson was excited about the opportunity, especially since she donates ten percent of all her winnings to the fight against childhood cancer.

Melby was competing at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo and told Dickson, "You're going to have to do all the work." Dickson asked Melby for a pair of her pants and went to work. On Saturday, the two met at the Fort Worth rodeo. Melby's husband Ryan got her horse ready and she put on her new wardrobe. Melby's, whose quiet personality is usually reflected in her wardrobe, surprised many who have known her for years by wearing colorful magenta.

"What I learned is that it was amazing how I turned everybody's head just walking from my trailer to the arena," Melby said, "and not in a bad way, when I walked through the parking lot they noticed me. It put smiles on people's faces."

"Even my husband was excited," she said, "he said 'it made your cheeks rosy. It made you shine."

Dickson's wardrobe assistance extended to Melby's tack and included a saddle cloth, leg wraps, breast collar and headstall accents. Although Melby finished just out of the money in all three rounds at the World's Original Indoor Rodeo, she won \$2,000 in the average.

Melby plans to sell her seasoned horses within the next few weeks and spend the summer close to home working with young horses. "My kids are 17 and 18 and I want to stay home for this last summer with them," she said.

Coliseum, posting a time of 16.53, but Anzick was left to wait it out in the back holding pen while the rest of the cowgirls ran.

"I knew we had a good run but I couldn't hear my time. The coliseum was so loud and everyone was whooping and hollering. I knew Shelley (Morgan) had a really good run and last to go was Danyelle," explained Anzick.

Bassett had a beautiful run going until a slip at the third barrel cost her the win. She posted a time of 17.11, which took her out of the contention for the average.

With the unfortunate slip, the title went to Anzick, making it two years in a row for a lefty.

"I was in shock! It felt like I was in a dream. Scooter worked absolutely phenomenal in the short round and he was spot on. There was no picking that run apart whatsoever. He was flawless."

Anzick's total time on three of 49.87 edged Morgan's total time on three of 49.88, for the championship title and a paycheck of \$7,001, boosting her winter run to \$15,126.

"Scooter is a phenomenal athlete. I am very blessed and lucky to get the chance to ride such an amazing horse. He definitely has what it takes and I am just going to be along for the ride and if he wants to go to the NFR, then by golly we will go to the NFR. Right now we have the Ram National Circuit Finals Rodeo to think about, which I am very excited for and I think he will do great in that arena," Anzick exclaimed.

In addition to winning Fort Worth, Anzick and Scooter are currently winning the Dixie National Rodeo held in Jackson, MS with only two days left and have made the progressive round at San Angelo, Texas, Monday morning.

Cline Clenches Championship Title

Andrea Cline and her great horse Stitchs Streaknfame, a 6-year-old gelding by Firewater Ta Fame, and out of a Streakin Six mare, were crowned the champion barrel racer at Rapid City's Wrangler Champions Challenge held in conjunction with the Black Hills Stock Show and Rodeo. Wranglers Champion Challenge, presented by Justin Boots, was held February 4th at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center in the Barnett Arena, and was an event that hosted the best in the business all hoping to get a chunk of the \$108,000 added prize money. This was the first of the Wrangler Champions Challenge but definitely not the last.

Cline and Moses, as she affectionately calls her winning gelding, turned in a time of 12.41 to secure the win and pocket a nice paycheck of \$5,440. The field was tough, as 4 former NFR qualifiers finished up 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th, respectively. Trula Churchill ran a time of 12.46, good enough for a second place check of \$4,160, while Britany Diaz was third with a 12.55 for \$3,040, fourth was fan favorite Fallon Taylor with a 12.81 for \$2,080 and rounding out the top 5 was Lisa Lockhart with a time of a 12.82 for \$1,280.

"I was very excited to be given the opportunity to run at the Champions Challenge and the atmosphere and crowd in the building was unreal. It was a lot of fun and my horse worked awesome," explained Cline.

Cline and Moses are known more in the futurity arena than in the rodeo arena but that is slowly changing as Moses gets more accustomed to the rodeo scene.





While their time in the arena went smooth, the drive to Rapid City could've gone a bit smoother.

"We had a lot of truck problems going to Rapid City and the weather on the drive there was certainly not cooperating, getting down to negative 20. We were just happy we were able to make it. I talked my mom into coming with me and after the drive we had getting to Rapid, I was sure glad that Zorro and I were able to put together a nice run to redeem the drive there," laughed Miller. Miller and Zorro were able to edge out another Wilderness circuit team, the super star team of Sammi Bessert and her phenomenal gelding Tommy, in addition to multiple NFR qualifier Lisa Lockhart and her outstanding gelding Louie.






Auctioneer Lynn Weishaar, Reva, SD, and Announcer John E. Johnson from Piedmont, SD rolled through the rapid paced sale each afternoon with record books tallying 565 buyers registered from 16 states. Corporate sponsorship for 2014 included Exiss/Sooner; Ravelette Publishing, Inc.; Cattle Business Weekly; Scoggins Veterinary; and Larry Larson Photography, Inc.


