

Ivy Conrado & CFour Tibbie Stinson Triumph in Fort Worth, Take World Standings Lead

A busy 10 days for Ivy Conrado and her home-bred winner CFour Tibbie Stinson paid off huge dividends to the tune of \$17,464 the first weekend of February. Conrado had the biggest win of her career at the Fort Worth Stock for a \$14,510 paycheck and placed third at the Black Hills Stock Show & Rodeo in Rapid City for \$2,954.

Coupled with a reserve championship at the National Western in Denver in January, Conrado leads the WPRA World Standings with \$32,767 earned at 10 rodeos.

"It was very exciting," said Conrado, who wanted to thank her parents, Kelly Conrado and Cody Doig, and Debbie Mikkleson for their support, and Jess Harper for working on Tibbie before each run in Fort Worth. "Tibbie was a trooper."

Conrado made her first run at Fort Worth on Thursday, February 28. She and Tibbie posted a 16.77, which ended up just out of the money.

"I had never been there," she said. "Everyone is really worried

about their first barrel there, so I let Tibbie pick her speed. She got to rolling and almost missed it. She got up the pen a little bit but came back around it good. She had nice second and really smoked the third. She clocked good. It was really a fun run."

She and Tibbie hung out in Texas until the first go of San Angelo, which held its entire first round in slack on Monday, February 1.

"I tipped a barrel to win third in the first round," said Conrado. San

Angelo is a progressive rodeo so she won't be getting a second run there. "From San Angelo, I drove to Amarillo, where I stopped and tried to decide what to do (about the weather). I didn't know if I should go through Nebraska (which ended up getting hammered by snow storms and ground blizzards), go through Lamar or go to Raton (NM) and up to Pueblo. The next morning, I talked to a bunch of girls and everyone was going through Raton to Pueblo, so that's what I did."

Given her proximity to her Hudson, Colo., home, Conrado chose to head to her house to let her horses out to rest. There she awaited the arrival of her father, Kelly, who flew to Denver so she wouldn't have to make the potentially treacherous drive herself.

"We left at 7:30 and drove all night to Rapid," she said. "We got there about 3 in the morning and got the horses put up. Tibbie got a full 12 hours of rest before the Champions Challenge."

Conrado and Tibbie were just one out of placing in the Champions Challenge.

"I was in a perf the next day, while everyone else was up in slack the next morning. So, they got to drive during the day. We actually

Anzick tops crazy week at Fort Worth Rodeo with \$5,000 Jerry Ann Taylor Award by Johna Cravens

for the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo

Shelly Anzick finished a wild week of ups and downs at the 2016 Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo with an unexpected \$5,000 check as winner of the Jerry Ann Taylor Best Dressed Award.

The Shepherd, Montana, cowgirl came oh-so-close to winning her second Fort Worth championship buckle as well. Anzick had the fastest time at the Saturday, January 30, matinee performance for her first round run at the World's Original Indoor Rodeo®. She was the second cowgirl to run and was taking the polo wraps off her horse Scooter (Scooten ta Fame) as the sixth runner finished.

Unbeknownst to the 2012 Fort Worth champion, a bull had jumped out of chute 3 into the arena and ran down the alleyway behind the sixth runner, Tyra Kane.

"I was as far back in the corner of that holding pen as I could get, since I was finished running," she said. "I heard a bunch of noise, looked under Scooter's neck and that bull was coming in hot. I'm ranch-raised so I knew to get out of the way. I jumped up on the fence, but the bull got Scooter twice."

Several barrel racers and horses were hit by the bull, but none worse than Scooter. Anzick wasn't sure how badly he was hurt and kept her horse under a vet's watch for 24 hours.

"I knew that I needed to give him as much time as possible between runs as I could," she said. That meant taking her second round run on Saturday afternoon, February 6, and, if she finished in the top ten, coming back that night for the finals.

"I planned to pull him up if he didn't seem right (during the run)," Anzick said, but Scooter made a great run of 16.55 seconds to win the second round and put them first overall. That run was the fastest of the whole rodeo.

The barrel racing finished at a little after 4 p.m. and Anzick didn't have much time to decide what to wear that night. She got some help from two-time Jerry Ann Taylor Award-winner Kendra Dickson and her TrueColors custom clothing who offered her an outfit.

"I said I would be honored to wear something she made," Anzick said, adding that it takes a lot of effort to put together the outfit and match it with leg wraps and tack.

"Kendra is on top of it. She can sew and glue under pressure," Anzick remarked. "Even the hat was hers."

"The number one thing - it was comfortable. The pants felt like a custom fit. It was tasteful and beautiful enough to stand out, but not be loud. I couldn't have picked a better color," she said of the black with royal blue accents that she and Scooter wore in the finals. Anzick was shocked to win the award. As the overall leader, she was the final barrel racer to run and the deeper ground shifted just enough for Scooter to knock over a barrel, costing her the championship and bumping her to eighth overall.

"I finished my run and they were saying 'Ivy and Shelly' needed

to go to the arena," she said. "I was thinking 'but, I hit a barrel, you guys,' then they said best dressed. I was blown away! I've been to the short round three years in a row and I sure was honored to receive this award."

Anzick, who won the Fort Worth championship in 2014, still earned \$9,065 in barrel racing checks plus the best dressed award for total earnings of \$14,065, about \$500 less than barrel racing champ Ivy Conrado. Only four event champions earned more than Anzick did at Fort Worth.

The Jerry Ann Taylor Award is presented by the Women's Professional Rodeo Association and the National Cowgirl Hall of Fame and is only given at the National Finals Rodeo and at the finals of the World's Original Indoor Rodeo in Fort Worth. Taylor, a 1986 National Cowgirl Hall of Fame honoree was a flamboyant trick rider and roper who was known for her sense of style.

Pam Minick of Fort Worth, a National Cowgirl Museum and Hall of Fame board member and honoree and former WPRA vice president, said the award is to encourage women in professional rodeo to carry on the tradition of wearing colorful western attire in the rodeo arena.

Barrel racing has a long history with the World's Original Indoor Rodeo®. The Fort Worth rodeo began holding an invitational ranch girls barrel race in 1955, not long after barrel racing competition started.

Prelims of world's richest one-day rodeo start Wednesday in Fort Worth Stockyards

This is no stock show. In fact, it's not a typical rodeo at all. The preliminary leg of RFD-TV's \$2 million event, THE AMERICAN, presented by Polaris RANGER, returns to Fort Worth's Cowtown Coliseum on Feb. 17-18 with timed-event competition, and with performances on Feb. 19-20 at 7 p.m. and Feb. 21 at 2 p.m.

The annual half-million-dollar American Semi-Finals will showcase more than 500 of America's top ropers and riders as they battle for fewer than 50 slots in The AMERICAN, held one week later inside AT&T Stadium. There, on Feb. 28, the Cowtown winners won't just compete for shares of a \$1 million purse, but also for a \$1 million bonus available to whomever can defeat the top 10 athletes in the world.

A competitor at the inaugural Semi-Finals in 2014, collegiate bareback rider Richmond Champion, became rodeo's first instant millionaire following an eight-second ride in the home of the Dallas Cowboys. He earned \$1.1 million – all because of the rodeo in Cowtown.

"To me, the Semi-Finals is so exciting to watch not only because of its own status as one of the top-10 richest rodeos in the world, but also because millions more dollars are at stake for each contestant," said Randy Bernard, CEO of RFD-TV Events. "And the diversity at Cowtown Coliseum is unequaled. Fans get to watch per-

decided to stay there the night instead of driving the whole night through for my second run at Fort Worth. We drove all day the next day."

They made their second run, a second-place finishing 16.62, at Fort Worth in the Saturday afternoon performance at Fort Worth with the Finals there that night.

"I was trying to have a smooth run," Conrado said of her second-run game plans. "I wasn't trying to be any faster. Tibbie went out there and turned the first a little bit better than my first run, turned a good second and smoked the third. She ran really hard. She runs hard every single time. She gives her all every single run."

A consistent time of 16.65, which tied for second in the short, gave her the average win.

"In the short round, I nailed the first barrel," she quipped. "I finally got my timing just right on it. She smoked the first. She turned a really good second, but tripped a little coming out of the third, which caused us to over-turn it a little bit, but it didn't slow us down."

Raised by the Conrados, Tibbie, a 7-year-old mare, is by the Dash Ta Fame son Eddie Stinson and out of Little Fancy Granny, by Del Puerto Bill. Affectionately known as Racie, Little Fancy Granny has a been a longtime favorite of the Conrados, winning for the entire family at all levels of competition.

Tibbie herself was a standout as a 4-year-old futurity horse, but even though her father had trained Tibbie and Ivy, herself, had won so much on Tibbie's mother, it wasn't an instant fit for the pair.

"It took a long time," Conrado admitted. "I have hit more barrels on that horse than any other horse I've ever rode. My first six months on her, other than when I randomly jump rode her derby year when my dad was still running her, I struggled. I had such a hard time with her. She just runs so hard and there's no forgiveness. They're no slide. Right when you ask her to turn is when she's going to turn, and I've finally gotten the hang of it. Finally!"


Tibbie wasn't the only horse with Conrado connections in the Finals at Fort Worth. Andrea Busby placed aboard Kellies Chick ("Skye"), who was Ivy's horse originally.

"I had Skye when Dad had Tibbie," noted Conrado. In fact, the father/daughter horse duo won the Sand Cup futurity and maturity together in 2013. "We had bought Skye for a broodmare. We wanted an AAA daughter of Darkelly to breed to the stud we had then. Cody Hyde found her for us and he told us he thought we should try her on the barrels. We didn't have time, so Dad told Cody to do it. She just took to it. She was a natural."

Conrado made about 25 runs on the mare, winning 18 of them, before she was sold to Charlie Cole and Jason Martin. Skye helped Michele McLeod qualify to three National Finals Rodeo appearances before the Busbys purchased her last fall.

"We're really good friends with the Busbys and my dad is riding

some of their horses," she said. "I love that I get to be around her. She's special to me."

The winter schedule will continue to be a grind as Conrado has made the cut for the mega-paying rodeos in San Antonio and Houston. She and Tibbie will also have the American Semifinals Rodeo on her schedule.



Shootout in the Black Hills -- D'Ann Gehlsen and Streaking Sonofagun Take Rapid City

"You can't win if you don't enter" is a common rodeo saying. Wanting to step out of her comfort zone, D'Ann Gehlsen entered the Black Hills Stock Show & Rodeo in Rapid City thinking that she would get drawn out on qualifications, but much to her surprise she was running in her first preference, the Saturday afternoon performance and winning the rodeo.

"I've gone and watched," said the Mission, S.D., barrel racer, "but I've never entered it. I go to a lot of Amateur rodeos and I just told myself that I needed to get out more and go to bigger and better things, so that's why I entered."

She and her 8-year-old homegrown gelding Streaking Sonofagun ("Radar") stopped the clock in 12.46 to win \$4,545. It was the gelding's pro rodeo debut.

"I knew he was capable," she said of Radar, "but we normally don't run in that type of a pen. It was a bit surprising. I don't prefer that type of pen. It's very small. Before, the horses that I had they were big pen horses. This horse is a big pen horse too but he's pretty quick. I kind of had a shot with him of all the horses that I've had to run. He was going to be a little bit better for that type of a pen."

Gehlsen and her husband Carl raised Radar, who is by leading barrel horse sire A Streak Of Fling ("Streaker"). Ironically, they hadn't planned on Radar being by Streaker as they already had an older full brother on the ground. She had purchased a breeding to a different stallion through a benefit auction, but couldn't get the semen when she needed to breed her mare.

"She was going out and needed to be bred," Gehlsen said. "I liked the Streaker that was on her side, so I took her to Streaker in



Ainsworth."

She said her husband is responsible for imprinting Radar too well as the gelding is large on personality.

"From the time he was 2-years-old, he's run everything. He's in

charge. He's an ornery bugger," she laughed.

Gehlsen said Radar was easy to train. He was started under saddle by Gabe Taylor.

"He rode him for 30 or 60 days in the fall," she said. "He called me within two weeks and told me what a nice horse I had. I rode him after that because he was that easy. He's very easy to get along with, very willing."

Radar ran at the northern futurities as a 5-year-old before starting his rodeo career as a 6-year-old.

"He did really good but he got hurt in the fall of his 6-year-old year," she said. "He was out from October until April/May of the next year. During that time, he got really large. He's 16.2 hands and 1335 pounds. I hear it all the time "That's got to be the biggest Streaker I've ever seen!""

Ironically, his dam Gunny is a diminutive 14.2. Gunny is by Back To Cash, a son of the Thoroughbred Master Hand out of a Dash For Cash mare, and out of a granddaughter of Go Man Go. "I bought the mare for \$1000," she Gehlsen, who works for the USDA Farm Service Agency. "Radar was her last colt. She foun-

dered after he was born and never could stay bred afterward." Raising horses is in Gehlsen's blood. Her father still raises horses today at age 84.

"Growing up, I mainly did the horse show thing—halter, Pleasure, poles, barrels," she said. "As I got older and with the politics of it, I went to the timed events."

After years of running successfully at the open, amateur associations in South Dakota and Nebraska, Gehlsen is going to try her hand at more pro rodeos.

"When the first of the year rolled around the goal was to enter a few more pro rodeos and qualify for the circuit finals," said Gehlsen, who wanted to thank her husband and close friends for their support as well as her farrier Jeremy Cass for his good work on Radar's feet. "I've always wanted to enter a couple of the larger rodeos like Cheyenne and Dodge City, and we'll see if they end up there or not."

formances by everyone from NFR qualifiers with dozens of world titles to phenomenal young kids to retired celebrities."

During the Semi-Finals last year, the Stockyards fielded athletes of all ages and genders from 36 states, four Canadian provinces, Australia and Brazil. In fact, a 9-year-old cowgirl from Stephenville banked \$44,279 and was then featured by ESPN SportsCenter, USA Today, and the Wall Street Journal as she tried to earn \$1 million.

"There's just no other way to win that much money at one event that's open to the world," said her father, Casey Chamberlain. "It's by far the best thing that ever happened to rodeo, in my opinion."

In addition, the event will feature a new American freestyle bullfighting contest. Each man is judged for 60 seconds while he tries to avoid an aggressive bull using extreme athleticism.

Judge rules on ERA lawsuit

On Feb. 4, the PRCA prevailed in its opposition to named Plaintiffs ERA, Trevor Brazile, Bobby Mote and Ryan Motes' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction in their suit brought against the PRCA. Ordering their motion denied, United States District Judge Barbara Lynn concluded that, "Plaintiffs have not made a clear showing that they will suffer irreparable harm absent a preliminary injunction, nor that they are likely to succeed on the merits of their claims."

The PRCA Bylaws at issue will be immediately enforced.

Four-time World Champion Bareback Rider, Kaycee Feild, expressed his level of dedication by saying, "I'm all in! I'm proud of being part of the ERA and holding stock. I know the future is bright for all of rodeo with the ERA. I stand for what's right and that's doing what I can to make the ERA the best!"

When asked what fans can expect at the upcoming tour rodeos, Tommy Joe Lucia, COO of the ERA said, "The ERA product has not changed, we will still be the best rodeo product in the industry showcasing the top rodeo athletes in the world."

On Feb. 10, a dozen individuals will saddle up at The San Antonio Rose Palace with skills that have earned them a collective 54 world championships, or "gold buckles," in professional rodeo. They'll compete head-to-head for exemptions into RFD-TV's \$2 million rodeo, The American, presented by Polaris Ranger, on Feb. 28 inside AT&T Stadium. There, in Arlington, those exemption winners will have a shot at earning \$1 million. To date, the largest paycheck a rodeo athlete has ever earned outside The American is roughly \$100,000.

WHO: The icons of the sport in tie-down roping, steer wrestling, barrel racing and team roping. Specifically, Cody Ohl of Hico, Texas vs. Fred Whitfield of Hockley, Texas (they've earned 14 world championships between them); Rope Myers of Van, Texas (who's wrestled his way to \$1.2 million) vs. Lee Graves of Alberta, Canada (two world titles and \$1.6 million); and world champion barrel racer Lindsay Sears of Nanton, Alberta vs. world champ Kelly Kaminski of Bellville, Texas. The six participating legends own a staggering 32 gold buckles, including headers Jake Barnes (7), Speed Williams (8) and Tee Woolman (3); pairing with heelers Allen Bach (4), Rich Skelton (8) and Walt Woodard (2). Bach, Skelton and Woodard are all from the Dallas/Fort Worth area; Williams is from Deleon and Woolman from Llano.
