# One For The Ages – Lisa Lockhart & An Oakie With Cash win RFD-TV's THE AMERICAN

She's by far one of the best in the world. She's trained multiple horses that have carried her to the National Finals Rodeo. She's hauled just enough to get there, yet is always a player in Vegas. She hauls when she has to, but rather not. She makes each and every run count because it means she'll be one run closer—not to the NFR or Canadian Finals—to going home to her family.

School board meetings, track meets, and junior rodeos have priority, and for that, Lisa Lockhart of Oelrichs, S.D., exemplifies the selflessness of rural Americans—the viewers of RFD-TV, the fans of rodeo. Work hard, play hard and take care of what matters most—family—and for that, she's the perfect barrel racer to hold the title of THE AMERICAN Champion.

In dramatic fashion, Lockhart and her beloved mount An Oakie With Cash ("Louie") posted the only clean-run of the clean slate Shootout to win \$100,000 at the World's Richest One Day Rodeo, RFD-TV's THE AMERICAN, presented by Polaris RANGER, held on March 2 at the Dallas Cowboy's AT&T Stadium in Arlington. Texas.

"It's a life-changing experience," said Lockhart, a multiple NFR qualifier and two-time Canadian Champion Barrel Racer. "Any time you win that kind of money it's surreal. I can't even fathom \$100,000! It's not really sunk in yet!"

In addition to the \$100,000—which she won free and clear as member of the invited Top 10 WPRA contestants, Lockhart had no entry fees tied up in the event—she won a Polaris RANGER, Cactus saddle, Bohlin belt buckle and Browning rifle.

"It just doesn't seem real," she said. "I don't read the fine print. I just show up and run, so I didn't even know about the Polaris Ranger or the \$15,000 buckle with real diamonds in it. The sponsorship and what Randy Bernard and RFD-TV did were above and beyond. It was absolutely beyond amazing. Even the setting in the stadium was absolutely amazing."

With 21 contestants, the WPRA Top 10, the top 10 qualifiers and 11-time WPRA World Champion Charmayne James as the legends exemption, barrel racing had the largest field of THE AMERICAN. Under the supervision of the Better Barrel Races association, the ground was worked after every five contestants.

Lockhart said the ground, which was her greatest concern going into the event, was a total non-entity.

"From what I could tell and from what I heard from the other girls, it was fine," she said. "It held everybody. It was awesome. The fact that they came in and drug after every five . . . that was very

much appreciated. They worked hard at it."

In the qualifying round, Lockhart was in the last set of five and had the top of the ground. What ended up being the deciding factor for the race was the first barrel with a standing-start approach and short score.

"Not getting in there, not getting to go through, there are a lot of what ifs going through your mind," she said. Lockhart skipped the 30-minute practice session on Friday night, opting to give Louie a leisurely trip from Scottsdale, Ariz., where she won the Champions Challenge on Thursday and placed in the pro rodeo out of Friday morning slack.

"I try not to watch, but I did watch a few before me just to see how it was. I knew they were having a little trouble with the first. I was concentrating on trying to nail that first barrel. Going to it I was thinking he felt pretty free. I didn't know if he was spot-on like he usually is. I had asked him pretty hard, and I said whoa, which is something I normally don't do; I can count on one hand the number of times that I've done that. I think the standing start made

# RFD-TV'S THE AMERICAN Pays Out \$1.1 million to Bareback Rider, Richmond Champion

Cowboys and cowgirls from across the world gathered at AT&T Stadium for their chance at the \$2 million dollar payout. Underdogs, legends and world champions competed in seven events on Texas Independence Day. As promised by President and CEO Randy Bernard, \$2 million, in total prize money was paid out. Each RFD-TV's THE AMERICAN event champion received a \$100 thousand dollar paycheck along with a prize package totaling more than \$27,000 (a Polaris RANGER, a custom Cactus trophy saddle, a Bohlin Buckle and a Browning Gun.)

"THE AMERICAN was created to provide an opportunity for qualifiers to compete against the best in the world. It truly was a historic day for western sport athletes. I would like to thank the sponsors, contestants and fans for supporting and making this vision a reality," stated Randy Bernard, President and CEO of Rural Media Group.

History was made when The Woodlands, Texan, Richmond Champion was the only qualifier to win his event. The 21-year-old Bareback Rider was one of 46 qualifiers and 9 exemptions eligible for the million dollar side pot.

Champion said, "I felt really good coming out of the Mesquite Semifinals. It was a huge confidence boost. When you come to an event like THE AMERICAN you have to set goals. After my second ride it started to hit me that I would have a chance at the million dollars."

it more challenging. You definitely had to be more reactive to the situation and how it was set up."

Lockhart, who had to lift her leg to keep the first barrel up, was the fastest qualifier with a 13.983, the only clean sub-14 second run of the rodeo. She was joined in the Shootout Round by Robyn Herring and Firewaterontherocks, Jane Melby and First Down Perk, and Shelly Anzick and Scooten Ta Fame.

Shockingly, all three of her fellow finalist hit barrels. Rather than change her game plan and safety up, Lockhart went for it, posting a 14.035.

"It was happening so fast," Lockhart said. "I was trying to figure out in an instant what I needed to do. At first you're thinking be safe, and the next your thinking there's still money for second and you can't go slow. I would have liked to have said, 'Just wait a minute. I would like to call my husband and discuss this,' but I don't think they would have gone for that. I thought just go for it and try to do your job. When you change things that's when things don't go as planned. My horse is broke enough and I'm confident that I could place him enough to go where I needed to go and ride him like I need to ride him. So I went with that. We've all been in that situation where you tell yourself don't hit it, but then you don't do what you're supposed to do. I figured I had all to gain and nothing to lose, just go see what happens."

From the time she pulled up in the alleyway, Lockhart was petting on Louie, an 11-year-old buckskin gelding that was raised by the Bagnell family of Polson, Mont. He is by their all-around performance stallion Biebers Oakie, a reining and reined cowhorse money earner that went to the NFR as a backup calf horse for Mike Johnson, and out of Lady Kaweah Cash, a daughter of multiple NFR sire Judge Cash.

The Bagnells had sent Louie to Lockhart to train for barrels, and he never left. She fell in love with the gelding's talent and personality. As the Bagnell family as stated many times, they had no choice



but to leave him with Lockhart because they couldn't stand to see her cry.

On stage to receive her awards following her run, Lockhart was reduced to tears—overwhelmed by the victory and missing her family—husband Grady, daughter Alyssa and sons Thane and Kade, who watched the event on RFD-TV.

"It stinks," Lockhart said, missing her family while she's out on the road. "You want to be there so badly. It's just heartbreaking that I'm not there for them. You never get used to it. I cry when I leave



home. We always say you do what you got to do. I'm thankful that I'm able to come home when I do because it could always be worse. I could be forced to be gone longer. If that were the case, I probably wouldn't do it."

Lockhart grew up in Eastern Montana and has been horse mad since she was a young child.

"I've done this all my life," she said. "Since I've been 6-years-old, I've been horse crazy and hooked. It's all I live, breathe and think." Although she said there's nothing she'd rather do than train horses, Lockhart does have a teaching degree and taught school for one year.

"My youngest asked me two years ago, when I was going to stop and get a real job," she laughed. "I want to ask him now if he thinks I should get a real job!"

For now, Lockhart's real job is qualifying for the NFR and







The Fort Hancock, Texas, barrel racer and Heza Bug Leo, owned by Trip and Callie duPerier, raced their way in by virtue of their San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Championship.

Everyone made their first run on February 10, with the top 120 coming back into the performances. The rodeo also held their finals on Friday night so contestants wouldn't have a conflict with RFD-TV's THE AMERICAN.

"I love the format," added Bean. "They even opened it up and took more people back to the performances. It's a great rodeo. I love San Angelo. They're very hospitable. They try to help you out. They want everyone to have the same chance. They hand raked after every runner in the perfs. It was great."






For the first go, everyone made one run in the Community Credit Spur Arena. Jana and Bugs were out of the money with a 15.03.

set at San Antonio," she explained. "We ran Sunday in San Antonio, jumped in the truck and ran in slack at San Angelo the next morning. I think he ended up 32nd in the first round. It was really deep when we ran and he did about as good as he could. I jumped him right back in the trailer and went back to San Antonio and won the round on him that night."

Bean qualified for the finals in San Antonio but had ground trouble.

"We were last out and he had little bit of trouble trying to get ahold of the ground," she said. "That's the big money round and there's no average, so you just have to go for it."

She made her second run at San Angelo last Wednesday night, this time in the Forster Communications Coliseum. She and Bugs posted a 14.58 to place fourth.

"He made a great run and was as honest as I could ask him to be," she said. "He turned three excellent barrels and ran hard."

They drew up great for the short round. As the second runner out, they posted a 14.48, to give them the average win.

"He got by the first just a tick and then just nailed the second and third," she said. "He ran hard and had the fastest time of

the whole rodeo. He gave me a chance to win the whole rodeo and now I get to go to Houston."

Bean started riding Bugs, a 9-year-old gelding by Shawne Bug Leo out of County Line Liz, by Mister Te Jay, some last May. The futurity standout trained by LaTricia Duke went to the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo with Angie Meadors after being sold to Trip and Callie duPerier of Boerne, Texas. Bean was already riding their horse Dash Ta Freedom, whom she finished out and campaigned

for her friend Claire Powell, before he sold.

"He's a great horse," Bean said of Bugs. "He's one of the neatest horses that I've been blessed to ride. He's so gritty and tries so hard. He just loves his job. He makes my job easy.'

So far this year, Bugs has carried the load, while Freedom has only ran at Fort Worth and Tucson.

"He's a lot freer running than Freedom," she explained. "The only thing you have to do on Bugs is get him shut down at that first barrel, and as LaTricia told me-when I first started riding him, naturally, I called her - all you have to do is clear his shoulder on the second and third and you'll be good. So, when I go into run, that's all I think—clear his shoulder, just clear his shoulder."

With Callie back running after her accident in the practice pen the Monday before THE AMERICAN Semifinals, Bean and duPerier will finish out the Texas rodeos before heading West for Logandale, Nev., and the California spring run of rodeos.

"I'm going to concentrate more on the rodeos this year," said Bean, who's a regular at the larger futurities. "I've got an opportunity to go with the duPeriers. They're great people and they've blessed me with great horses to ride and the opportunity to go. We're going to

try it out."

The goal for both Callie and Bean is to end up in Las Vegas in December.

"Whatever God's plan is for us is where we'll end up," she said. "I've gone, but I've never got to go and stay at it. With the opportunity we have this year we're going to give it a try. We're going to try to help Callie win Rookie and see if we can't get her to the finals. If
