Rundown Recap – Happy, Healthy Horses

Veterinarians once ranked barrel racing as one of the most physically demanding of all equine sports. It was second only to polo in terms of overall exertion and physicality.

Not surprisingly it takes a lot of the keep a barrel horse happy and healthy. Yet, it doesn't always mean rushing to the veterinarian for every little thing or using every new therapeutic modality on the market.

Here, Barrel Racing Report visited with two WPRA barrel racers—current WPRA Top 15 member Ivy Hurst and two-time WPRA Reserve World Champion Lisa Lockhart---and two top futurity horse trainers—multiple aged event champion Craig Brooks and recent Texas Extreme Futurity Champion Dustin Angelle—for their thoughts on how to keep horses happy, healthy and winning.

Ivy Hurst

Ivy Hurst and her 13-year-old gelding Top Of The Roc have had a very solid 2020 pro rodeo season. As the winter run was drawing to close she made the comment that she wanted to spend some time focusing on her horse's mental health—just letting him relax from the strenuous runs and periodic tuning sessions to keep him sharp—before heading out for a long summer.

"I told my husband that I wanted to just trail ride him some and let him come down," she chuckled. "Well, that's all that we're doing now! Today (Monday) was the first day in a long time that I galloped around the barrels. It's time to start get ready to get back going again."

The main way she keeps her horses happy and healthy, is turnout and downtime, a good conditioning program and lots of TLC.

"Mine spend a lot of time turned out," said Hurst. "We've had a lot of rain and the grass is really good, so mine have been out. I think it's good for their joints and it's good for their mind. It's something they don't normally get a lot of while we are traveling."

Hurst admits she's had to back off on the feed because natural forage was doing its job to well.

"That's something the people need to take into consideration, adjusting your program when you're not moving and going a bunch," she said. "Maybe they don't need all that high powered stuff, if they're getting all that green grass."

During the grind of the rodeo season it's another story.

"When I'm on the road, I do up my supplements a little," she said. "I try to keep forage in front of them at all times because they do get so stressed on the road. It took me years to learn the ulcer routine—what works and what doesn't—and not all horses react the same to each product. Some horses can be fine on compounded omeprazole, while others need GastroGard. That's one of the challenges, figuring out what works for each horse."

Hurst typically hauls two geldings together and keeps them together on the road.

"Usually I take two gelding who live together at home," she said. "If you can take two horses that love each other and put them together, they will eat better and drink more. It becomes a contest.

Even at the truck stop!"

When she's on the road, she'll try to keep her horses in hot-wire traps as much as possible because her horse are used to having turnout.

"If I have the choice been a hot-wire pen and stall, I'm going to build the pen if I can," she said. "Grazing, I feel just keeps them happy."

If she has to stall, she'll put each horse across from each other instead of side-by-side if the stall walls are solid and they can't see each other.

"When they can't see each other that just catapults you into the ulcer situation," she said. It's also water first, then hay and grain to get them hydrated before adding the bulk of their meal.

Something she's also adamant about when hauling is stopping to let her horses get their heads down to drain their respiratory passages.

"I'm so big on letting them eat off the ground," she said. "If I stop at truck stop after seven or eight hours on the road, it isn't always about walking the horse as much as it is letting them get their head down, even if I have to put a feed pan down to do it. I can guarantee you their going to blow their nose at least twice if not a third time."

Hurst also tries to keep her horses moving rather than resting all the time.

"I definitely try to keep them rode, even if it's just taking them for a 10 minute walk," she said. "Say I'm going to Reno. I'll stop half way and get up and just ride them for 10 minutes before I go on the rest of the way, just to move them around."

"I learned the hard way a few years back. I thought just let them rest as much as you can, but I got to Logandale one year and started work-

ing my horse and it tied up. This horse had never tied up before. I drove half-way across the country and didn't even get to make my run. We drove for two days straight, kept him in a stall where he wasn't able to move.

"Whether it's riding them for 10 minutes or ponying...I try to get them moving a little every single day. It's good for their joints and it's good for you just to get on them see how they feel."

Prior to the busy portions of her rodeo season, like before the winter run and summer run, Hurst will visit her chiropractor Daryl Elliot and veterinarian Josh Harvey to have her horses gone over.

"Everyone gets a once through before I head out on the road," she said. "I usually try to do it two weeks before I go so they can get comfortable and I can get a run on them before the super-big run for a lot of money. I want them to understand they feel better." For general wellness during the season, she has several therapies that she enjoys using on her horses.

"I like my PHT products," she said. "I rented a Magna Wave. I didn't know you could do that. It's very affordable to do. I really like Runner's Relief. That's something I added to my program last year. When I'm hauling I wrap their legs and put their Soft Rides on. Sometimes it's the little things, like fly sheets and wraps so they can

sleep without stomping all night.”

Hurst did say when things aren't going right, she's going to spend time in the saddle before she spend money at the vet or on a therapeutic modality.

“If something isn't going right, I'm going to spend more time in the saddle. From there, I'm going to the vet. If things still aren't right, I might try other things. When you're on the road, there are times when you have to use your therapies to get you by until you have time to ride or get to the vet.”

For Craig Brooks, consistency is the key to keeping his horses happy and healthy. He strives to stay consistent with short, productive rides, plenty of turnout and heading off any soreness before it becomes a physical and mental issue.

“I'm pretty consistent on the riding aspect of it,” said Brooks. “I'll narrow that down as they get older, but

I'm pretty consistent on making sure they get rode. I'm big on short rides. I'll pick on a horse (train on something specific), but I do it in short increments. I step on them, trot to the arena and get to work. If they go to work and do what I ask them, it's a 10-15 minute ride. It's not long.”

Brooks said he had an owner compare his training to that of a military drill sergeant.

“I have a big work ethic so I want a horse with a lot of work ethic,” he said. “I don't want to go out there and lope 10 to 15 minutes' worth of circles to get warmed up. We trot out there and I expect them to work without having to piddle around. I go straight to work, get it done and then I'm finished. I feel like I can get more accomplished in a short ride and keep those colts progressing. If you have to ride them until they're tired that's when the fight begins and they can struggle.”

Lots of turnout time makes it possible for Brooks to eliminate the need for extra riding.

“I have eight individual turnouts,” he explained. “I don't turn anything out together. Once a horse comes into the barn, they don't go back out together again. I don't like to turn horses out together. No good things happen when they're out together and I don't like them to get attached. I am very big on the turnout. It makes it easier for me because they are ready to ride when I step on. If they're standing up in the barn, when you do get on them on they're going to be fresh and playful and you're going to have to ride that out of them. The turnout is really important for me.”

As far as his feeding and supplement programs go, Brooks keeps it simple. About the only supplement he has his colts on is Stierwelts Super Flex.

To stay competitive and keep his horses progressing, Brooks will also have his horses gone over by a veterinarian periodically. The

exam isn't necessarily for anything noticeably wrong. Rather, it's a preventive to keep a soreness from developing into a full blown lameness, which not only requires time and effort to fix, but you also have the fix the mental and training problems that result.

“Prior to the start of the futurities, maybe three or four months in or prior to the big futurities, we'll have them gone over,” he said. “I had an owner ask me why I was going to the vet. They wanted to know if I thought something was wrong. Sometimes I do go to the vet because I think something is wrong, but a lot of times I go to keep things from going wrong.

“At the same time, I'm not one to spend a lot of my money or my owners money at the vet. I'm not that guy that runs to the vet every time I have a problem, but I'm also not the guy that waits until there is a full-blown problem.

“If a horse does something, like getting flat on a barrel—well that's just a barrel horse for you. I'm going to spend some time working on that and if it doesn't come around in short order in a couple of days, I might go explore a little bit.”

Brooks admits that experience has allowed him to make the judgement call between going to the vet or focusing more on the horse's education, but it's not something everyone has the knowledge to do.

“That's a trainers perspective,” he said. “The open rider who bought their horse might not have it in their arsenal to know to go tune rather than go to the vet first.”

“More than anything, it's knowing your horse,” she said. “It's knowing everything about them. Their likes & dislikes, whether it's in the way you ride them, prepare them or the way you have to keep them happy pre-race. They'll tell you if you listen.”

Lisa Lockhart says the most important thing anyone can do to keep their horses happy and healthy is to know them.

keep them happy pre-race. They'll tell you if you listen."

Take her horses for instance.

"Louie is a little bit bossy," she said. "Cutter and Rosa get along great. It's not that Louie is mean, per se, but he's ornery and sometimes its too much. It works out great that Cutter and Rosa do get along well. (Louie) wasn't always the grouch. He learned that from Chisum. The older he's become the more of a grouch he has become. He wants to herd Cutter. Why? Because he can. He's just ornery. It's fun to watch and read their little minds. You can just see it coming sometimes."

She says there are merits to jumping through some hoops for your horses. For instance, what King Louie needs is what he's going to get.

"He panics when he's alone in certain situations," said Lockhart. "I've never made him work through it because it's not worth it. He will kick and throw fits, and it's just not worth him getting hurt. So, I accommodate him to a certain extent."

Lockhart says you don't want to go overboard on the accommodations though.

"There is a fine line between accommodating one and spoiling one," she added.

For general horse-keeping, Lockhart does keep her horses stalled some in the barn because it prepares them for what the rodeo road may bring.

"They do see a lot of turnout time as well," she said. "Early on, they didn't see a lot of stall time and it was hard on them when I started to go a lot of places. Now that I have the option to stall one, I do. They like it at night and when the weather is bad. I think it does help them to adapt to situations when we are on the road, too."

When she's on the road, she lets the horse tell her what they need.

"Louie prefers to be outside," she said. "Sometimes Cutter doesn't settle well in a strange pen and he will pace, so it's better for him to be stalled in certain situations.. If I haul until 2 a.m. and expect to put Cutter in a pen, he's going to pace. If I get there at 9 p.m. and he has time to settle in, we're good. It depends on so many factors and again knowing your horses."

Lockhart's horses also don't get a lot of the extra therapies that so many barrel racers are fond of using.

"I don't use a lot of alternative therapies in any manner," she said. "It's not so much that I don't want to (use them), it's having access. I don't have a lot of access to things like that where I'm at. Time is also a factor. If there are some things that I need to as far as therapy for an injury, I will get that taken care of and make that happen. But as far as owning any of the machines myself, I don't."

Her supplement program is fairly simple. She's been a Platinum Performance endorsed rider for many years and feeds Platinum Performance CJ, Osteo and Longevity.

And like anyone hauling these days, she also keeps her horse on ulcer preventives.

"It's a constant thing," she said. "It's one of those things that you're always trying to stay one step ahead of."

As far as her veterinary work, she'll have periodic maintenance done based on her rodeo seasons. She's had a long-standing relationship with her veterinarian that allows her stay on top of her horse's physical health.

"I've used Dr. Terry Swanson at Littleton (Colorado) for 25 years now," she said. "Anytime I need something in between I can call. Sometimes I'm calling him daily. It's a long way from my house but well worth my effort to see him. He knows my horses so well and that's so helpful. He also trusts in my intuition."

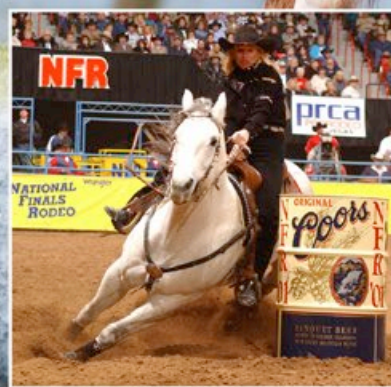

Dustin Angelle

For Dustin Angelle, the secret to keeping his horses happy and healthy is his feed program.

"We feed Nutrena Pro Force Fuel and Hay-Rite Alfalfa Cubes with oats in them. Our mares and babies get the Nutrena Mare & Foal. My Nutrena reps still come out once every six months. They go through all the horses and help me if we need to make any changes."

Angelle said having a feed company rep visit periodically has been very helpful even though he usually gets in trouble because he likes a heavier horse. "I almost always get in trouble for feeding too much," he chuckled.

Supplement wise all of his horse get a topline supplement. "I like to keep all my horses on it because we get in a lot of babies and those horses aren't all the way developed yet. I feel the Pro Elite helps them develop more," he said.

Stable-wise, Angelle has his training horses stalled. Only the mares and foals have pasture. Since his youngsters don't have access to turnout, they go to the Eurociser daily.

"My older horses get worked in the Eurociser a lot more," he said. "With the younger horses, I'll spend more time on their backs. Everyone goes out everyday no matter what. They at least have to walk an hour in the Eurociser."

He said each horse may have a slightly different program built around its individual needs exercise-wise. Some will get a little bit more, while some will get less. It all depends on what the horse needs to stay fit.

"Coming from a racetrack, we're big with our consistency," he said. "All of our horses have individual programs and we stick to it. We don't change things up when they're working. I don't like for a horse to get worked three days and then have a week off. I feel like it doesn't do you any good."

Angelle also has an advantage being married to a vet, Clay Espey.

"Clay looks over the horses every evening when he helps me feed," Angelle said. "Once a week we go over the horses and do any vet work. If they need to be chiropracted, flexed and adjusted or injected."

"I have a dry erase board in the barn. During the week if I feel anything or any notice any changes, I put the horse's name on the board. On Thursdays, that's usually (Clay's) day off, he'll look at the board and go over those horses."

While he does have direct access to a veterinarian, Angelle knows that it can't keep him from doing his due diligence as a trainer first. Learning problems aren't always vet problems, especially with younger horses.

"If I start complaining a horse is doing something different, he usually tells me to give them a few chances first," he said. "I may give them a few days to see if they come out of it. A lot of times, I'll ask Clay to just check them for me and it will be nothing. It works to my advantage, but sometimes I overthink it because I have availability to it."

Angelle also has access to several therapeutic modalities: a cold water spa, MagnaWave, Theraplates, nebulizers, lasers and the like.

"It's really handy and we use it a lot, especially when we have futurities coming up," he said. "I use it on some of the 3-year-olds also. If Clay tells me a soreness is just 'growing pains,' we'll use them on those horses. Those babies aren't mature and more prone to getting body sore."

He knows the futurity horses will be needing a lot of extra TLC when events are allowed to move forward after the COVID crisis. It will be hard to skip and miss as much because so many lucrative events will be closer together due to the shortened year of eligibility for aged event horses.

"All of my horses get Zesterra when we go on the road," he said. "I use the cold water spa on the road too. We bring our MagnaWave

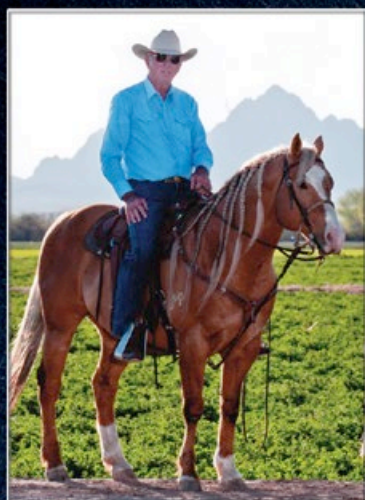
with us. I also try to make sure they're drinking as much as possible. Sometimes, I'll give Jail Break on top of the Zesterra. A lot of those horses will stress and draw up when we go somewhere so I try to stop it before it starts."

It's a lot of extra work, but necessary, says Angelle, who has been locked down in Louisiana since mid-March.

"It's tons of work to keep them happy, but I've never seen an unhappy horse keep winning. I don't think the difficult part is making a horse win; it's keeping a horse winning. That all goes back to their happiness—do they enjoy their job and did we do a good enough job to make it enjoyable for them." ~BRR

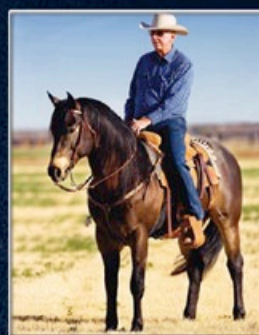

Jordon Briggs' First Barrel Drill

By Jordon Briggs with Bonnie Wheatley

It seems like the first barrel can be the hardest barrel to run a straight approach to without a horse leaning or anticipating. I think sometimes it's because in different setups you'll end up lopeing a circle before starting your run to the first barrel so it's easy to get in the habit of lifting the whole way to first. Or, you'll have horses that tend to lean going to first, that's just a habit they've developed in their training. Other horses will even move away and swoop out going to the first barrel.

The first barrel drill can help with all of these things by getting a horse balanced and straight going to the first barrel. Lots of patterns are set to where you come around a panel or somewhat of a corner and then line up for first pretty quick, so I feel that you have to train a horse to pick up its lead and run straight to their point where they'll need to start their turn.

Most races we go to have the alley way lined up to the third barrel so I'm always lining up my approach to first to where my pocket at third would be. This gives me a reference point for my position at the first barrel. The goal of my first barrel drill is to train for correct position to run to and correct body position in the horse. This drill is great for countering anticipation and leaning. It helps you ride to the correct spot for the turn.

I want to put my horse's hip in to pick up the correct lead for the first barrel, but then I want them to have their head straight and their hip staying underneath them, not leaning to the inside or the outside.

So, for this drill I do a 90-degree angle for the first barrel turn. I've found that some horses don't know how to lope straight to the first barrel without being over-bent or leaning on the inside rein. If you have to really lift on your horse to get them into the correct lead, then sometimes you end up really holding them the whole way to the first and they lean on your hands.

Barrel Racer Bio: Jordon Briggs

This drill counteracts that habit and is helpful for a horse that leans or needs to be squared up. I want my horses to run up the pen and stay squared up and driving from behind on their approach to the first barrel.

At that 90-degree point (see diagram) I want to guide them into the turn. You can do this first barrel drill to the left for a horse that runs to the left first or the right for a horse that takes the right barrel first.

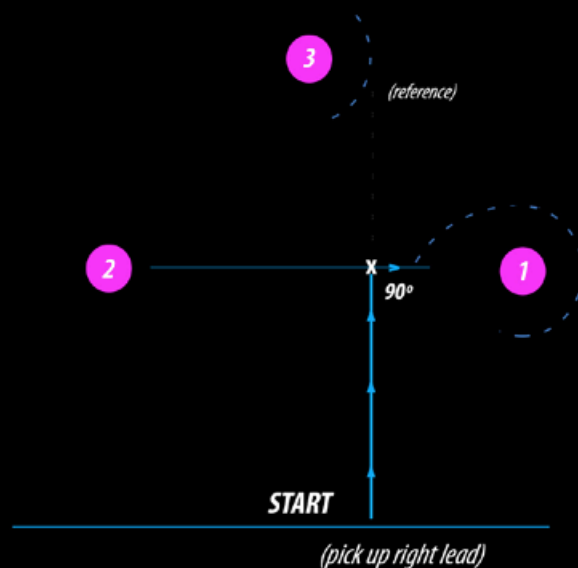
Jordon Briggs' First Barrel Drill

The diagram illustrates Jordon's reference point of her pocket at the third, which helps guide the approach to the first barrel.

Step 1. Jordon lines her horse up with her pocket to the third barrel and lopes or trots towards the first barrel.

Step 2. When the horse's nose is at the line she's drawn between the first and second barrels, that marks the start of her 90-degree first barrel turn. At that spot she will stop her horse and square up its body so it's balanced and straight.

Step 3. Then turn 90 degrees and proceeds to the first barrel she then turns the barrel and proceeds through the pattern.



How far along in training does my horse have to be for this type of pattern work?

All my horses, I want them to run in a straight line to the first barrel so I'm going to train for this at the outset even when just starting to work them through the pattern. It's also a great tuning exercise for a finished barrel horse to counter anticipation.

Preferred headgear for this drill?

I recommend using a shanked bridle or the bit you're usually tuning your horse in, something with enough leverage to allow you to get them stopped and rocked back on their butt. The bit I use depends on the stage of the horse's training and it's age too.

Leach and Smooth N Heavenly Get the Win

Social Distancing Barrel Race, Alvarado, TX

As we look forward, it looks like social distancing may be part of barrel racing's future for a while; so we thought it would be helpful to look into how the Social Distancing Barrel Race in Alvarado, TX operated over the weekend and ran 565 runners while maintaining a safe environment for everyone. Thank you to Mary Etta Cochran for providing the guidelines used at the barrel race.

Here are the guidelines they used:

- 3 days with 30 minute time slots available
- Ten riders each 30 minutes
- 15 minute warmup/exhibition, 5 run, drag, 5 more run each 30 minutes
- Social distance must be maintained & was monitored
- No spectators to video etc., no extra people
- Entered in back door, exited side door, then next 10 came in

Shea-lynn Leach McConnell topped the 565 runners over 3 days and since it was the first bigger barrel race in almost 6 weeks, the Barrel Racing Report caught up with her to discuss her big win.

BRR: Can you take us through your run?

Leach McConnell: Well that morning when I went to feed I noticed the horse that won second there last week (Louie Bug) was lame with an abscess. So I was super bummed. But I knew Smoothie could do it if I just placed him right at the barrels. He tends to want to shoulder sometimes so I worked on that during our exhibition. When he went in there I let him run harder and tried to focus on my spot and he swallowed up the first. Then I had to concentrate on getting him up into the hole on the second, I noticed he stayed honest so I just let him work and rode hard to the third. I don't have to push or whip, he's fast enough as it is! I'm just super proud of him!

BRR: Explain the process of the social distance barrel race and what it was like running there?

Leach McConnell: Smoothie is a 5 year old gelding by JL Dash Ta Heaven. He was trained and was futurity by Jolene Montgomery. Smoothie just has a very quick and fast style. He's very quick footed around a barrel and really runs hard in between. He doesn't always have the best attitude but he has proved he has the try to get it done!

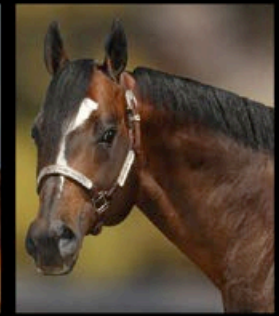

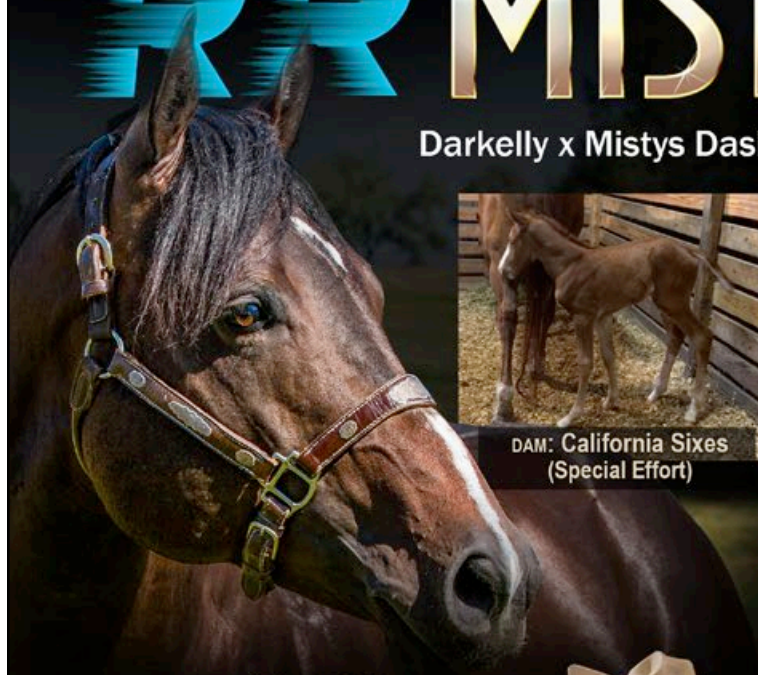

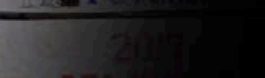

McBride and Zombie First Duo to Win Four Straight (1955-58) Barrel Racing World Titles

First appeared in WPRA News; By Jolee Lautaret Jordan

In modern times, rodeo records are broken nearly every year. But San Angelo, Texas, cowgirl Billie McBride held a professional barrel racing record for 30 years. McBride won four consecutive WPRA world championships from 1955 to 1958 – no other barrel racer could surpass that feat until 1988 when Charmayne James won her fifth straight title. To date, no one else, besides James, has won four titles, consecutively or otherwise.

McBride could hardly have envisioned the championships she would claim in her life when she was growing up as barrel racing was relatively new and the Girls Rodeo Association was non-existent in her early years.

"We rode all the time as kids, as you do when you grow up on a ranch or farm," says McBride of her and her sisters. "When I was 10-years old, we went to a rodeo and saw barrel racing."

It was the Belton, Texas Fourth of July rodeo in 1937. McBride told her father, "I can do that," and set out to prove she could. Riding a mare they called Trixie, McBride and her sisters Eulajeau, Donna Faye, and Delois began running barrels at home. They even hauled Trixie's mule colt along with them to the rodeos.

"Back then they ran straight barrels, it was before the cloverleaf," explains McBride. "So we did the straight barrels and flag raced. We went to amateur rodeos and events."

The McBride sisters were the only four sisters who rodeoed and ran barrels in the state of Texas. They are now enshrined in the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame.

When the GRA formed in 1948, McBride became a charter member. Sisters Eulajeau, and Donna Faye soon followed suit. With a new, professional association in which to compete, McBride continued running barrels and even took a turn at roping, as was common amongst the GRA founders.

"I tried to rope a bit," laughs McBride, "but I hurt my arm. I decided I would rather barrel race anyway. And I didn't want to mess up my mare!"

That mare was the American Quarter Horse Association registered Zombie A, known as Zombie. An average sized chestnut sorrel (14.2 hands), Zombie began her life as a race horse.

Running on the track just enough for her owners to realize she would be a short racer and probably didn't have the speed to make it, Zombie came to McBride in a trade for a roping horse.

"She just took to the barrels," McBride remembers of the talented mare. She started her at the age of four in 1954 and finished second in the world standings for the new GRA

behind teen LaTonne Sewalt.

Zombie was a phenom – McBride entered her in 99 events one season and only had an astounding one barrel penalty. At the age of just five, she collected her first GRA World championship.

"She always gave all she had," remembers McBride. "She was one hundred percent all the time."

Describing her as "a real nice mare," McBride says Zombie like everyone and was not ill tempered at all. She was a fast learner who could do anything she was taught to do.

Zombie ran at an average of 40 to 50 rodeos a year, at a time when GRA barrel racers often rode in every performance of a given rodeo. She ran hard and turned hard and was "automatic."

"She was real honest," says McBride. "There aren't too many mares that have won the world. She was a good one."

The pair won rodeos in Chicago, San Angelo, Phoenix and Tucson, Ariz., and Oklahoma City. The win in the Windy City earned McBride a pair of gold spurs.

"She didn't really like deep sand, but otherwise it made no difference to her about ground or arena size," says McBride.

McBride and Zombie dominated the world of professional barrel racing for four straight seasons. In those days there were no finals for the GRA so the titles were based on the regular season earnings. In 1958 Zombie collected \$6,498.

While earning world titles, McBride was also holding down a regular job in a boot shop. "They let me off to go rodeo," McBride remembers. "I felt then and still do, if you've got a good horse, you've got to go."

In the meantime, McBride was also helping lead the GRA as a director for 13 years, first as Vice President, and then President from 1957-1959. She would also later become the GRA Secretary, a post she would hold for three years. It was under McBride's leadership as President that the GRA barrel racers held their first season ending

Finals barrel race.

"We couldn't get into the NFR, they wouldn't take us," says McBride of the newly formed National Finals Rodeo hosted by the Rodeo Cowboys Association for the first time in 1959. "The steer ropers said they would have us. They thought it would add to their finals to have us there, and I think it did."

McBride worked for stock contractor Tommy Steiner. Steiner's advertising manager, John Van Kronkrite, worked as an unofficial spokesman for the GRA, helping put together the Finals. The GRA's first season finale was held with the RCA steer roping finals in Clayton, N.M., in 1959.

McBride was there – not just in an official capacity as President – but also as a competitor with Zombie.

"She had night blindness by then and the arena was outdoors so we didn't win much," McBride says of her last season with the great mare. But they still finished second in the final world standings.

It would be Zombie's last hurrah in the pro rodeo arena. She would eventually become McBride's grandkids' horse. They used the mare for barrels and stake racing.

"My granddaughter won a saddle on her when Zombie was about 22 or so and she was just nine years old," McBride remembers. "My daughter rode her as well – she knew when the kids were on her and just took care of them."

Zombie lived out her years in McBride's care. She passed away in 1977 at the age of 28.

McBride is a member of the Cowgirl Hall of Fame, inducted in 1981. Though she lives "in town" now and, at the age of 82, no longer owns any horses, McBride still remembers the

thrill of having a great one.

"She was just hard to beat, I don't care that she was mine," she says, "she was hard to beat." ~BRR

ProRodeo targeting Memorial Day weekend for rodeo competition

ProRodeo is targeting Memorial Day weekend for a return to competition, PRCA CEO George Taylor told The Cowboy Channel in an interview Saturday.

Taylor addressed several topics in the interview, including the affect the COVID-19 pandemic is having on PRCA rodeos and a timetable for the possible return of rodeos.

"You know, sooner is better, for sure," Taylor said. "We're really hopeful Memorial Day weekend (May 23-25) that we can get something started. We're working very closely right now with Fort Smith (Ark.) and the local officials there in order to have a rodeo. Whether that means it is a fan-less event or reduced occupancy style of event, that's really our direction and what we are going to try to pull off because we do need to get the rodeo engine going and have everybody in these communities see some encouraging things. We are really excited about the potential of starting that on Memorial Day weekend."

The "Kick Open the Chutes" PRCA incentive plan, which will help rodeo committees, is also something Taylor discussed.

"The big focus of this is, 'How do we get going?'" Taylor said. "What we are going to do as the PRCA is we're looking to partner with PRCA rodeo committees to begin to understand what they can do to just say, 'Yes.' ... These are challenging times. How can we supplement some of the things the local committees are trying to do, whether they have lost sponsors, their gate might be reduced substantially, or maybe we are just helping to try and give them a backstop of some additional funds."

"The PRCA wants all our committees and communities to know that we are very flexible, that we work with them on the format, the number of days, but we really want to get going and create some good for all of our membership, for the committees and the communities they serve, as well as their charities. We are starting out looking through June initially just to provide some incentive and some additional stimulus to get rodeo going."

Taylor also touched on the 2020 Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Dec. 3-12.

"We're having regular conversations with them and we have gone to weekly meetings," Taylor said. "We're really working on what's the format going to be in terms of additional entertainment we might have and how do we make this NFR even better than the last one. We're beginning to have some of those discussions now and (are) working with them. Obviously, it's really critical for Las Vegas to open back up. We're hearing some rumors that in May, early June, we will start to see some of the casinos open again. We can just hope and pray that there's no additional spikes of activity relative to the virus and that we can get that planned and have our season and have that crowning of our world champions on our normal schedule."

Taylor also talked about the Paycheck Protection Plan (PPP) and encouraging members to apply with new stimulus money available.

"The President (Donald Trump) just signed nearly another \$500 billion into stimulus that will help fund that," Taylor said. "Our membership, much of it, is eligible for those types of forgivable loans as they go forward. So, we're really wanting to make sure that our members are utilizing those things and pursuing them. The money had run out, but now it has been replenished, and we need to act fast and keep everybody with money and food on the table, if you will."

Calgary Stampede cancels for 2020 due to COVID-19

The Calgary Stampede, which partnered with the PRCA this season to have money won help determine qualifiers to the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo, announced April 23 in a press release that it would be canceling for 2020 due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic after the Chief Medical Officer of Health of Alberta banned all gatherings of more than 15 people for an indefinite period of time. The city of Calgary also has declared a state of local emergency.

"This is an extremely difficult announcement to share, but it is the right thing to do," said Dana Peers, Calgary Stampede President & Chairman of Board, in a press release issued by the Stampede. "As a community celebration, the cancellation of our annual event comes with our community and public health and safety front of mind."

PRCA CEO George Taylor echoed Peers.

"This is obviously disappointing to our members and ProRodeo fans around the world, but the PRCA certainly understands the challenges faced by the Calgary Stampede when more than 2.5 million people attend annually," Taylor said. "The safety of the fans and the people of Calgary is what's most important. Our hearts go out to all of those impacted by this cancellation, and we enthusiastically look forward to the 2021 Calgary Stampede."

The Calgary Stampede has been around for 108 years, been through two World Wars, the Great Depression and a devastating flood. But the loss of this year's Stampede is bigger than its not-for-profit organization. Many local businesses are part of the greater Stampede, from the restaurants, bars and hotels, to the retailers, ride-share and taxi drivers who support Western culture throughout the city.

"This is hard, but we need to make these types of decisions right now in order to stay safe and move forward," Tom Sampson, Chief, Calgary Emergency Management Agency, said in the release. "It's not what anyone wants to see happen but it's pretty much mandatory at this time, and we applaud the Stampede for putting the safety of all Calgarians and their guests first."
