Walker & Perculatin Win Inaugural Wrangler Champions Challenge

Reigning WPRA World Champion Mary Walker and her great horse Perculatin ("Latte") added another jewel to their crown with a \$4,000-victory at the inaugural Wrangler Champions Challenge, held May 18 in Redding, Calif.

The Wrangler Champions Challenge is a made-for-TV series that features the top 10 contestants in each event. The single-round rodeo offers an \$80,000 total purse. The top 10 competitors consist of the top seven from the 2012 World Standings, the top two in the 2013 standings 30-days prior to the rodeo and the host rodeo's 2012 champion.

Amarillo, Texas, Kissimmee, Fla., and Winnie, Texas, will host the three remaining Wrangler Champions Challenge Rodeos. Although Redding and Amarillo do not count towards 2013 Wrangler National Finals Rodeo qualifications earnings, Kissimmee and Winnie will count for 2014.

"The format was really good," said Walker, who hails from Ennis, Texas. "Just the fact that the same people are going to be on TV every time is exciting. You saw all the champions—the top 10 in each event. The rodeo was a sellout.

"It was a great rodeo. For the PRCA to include the WPRA girls—we're really appreciative of that. We want to thank them for including us."

The purpose of the Wrangler Champions Challenge is to build recognition and an athlete-centered fan base with the same contestants appearing throughout the series.

"At so many rodeos you don't always see the same people," Walker explained. "What they're trying to do is make it like basketball or baseball where you see the same people on TV every time, so you can get a fan base."

The Redding Wrangler Champions Challenge will air July 7 on GAC and will repeat on July 13.

Walker and Latte's 17.10 was the fastest of their runs in Redding. For the Redding Rodeo, held prior to the Challenge, Walker and Latte, placed eighth in the first go and second in the second go to finish second in the average for \$2,836.

Trula Churchill and A Streak Of Rita, who have had an exceptional spring run, won the rodeo after day-lighting the field with a 16.96 in to win the second go en route to a \$3,545 payday.

Walker said Latte's performance for the Redding Rodeo gave her plenty of confidence for the Challenge.

"He made two runs in that arena prior," she explained, "so I knew he liked it and would probably work well because it was his kind of pen. He really liked the ground. I was first on the drag so that to me was a plus."

Walker has had Latte out with her on the West Coast run since

Logandale in April. She's flown back to run Friscos Col George ("Tonka") at the bigger Texas spring rodeos like Corpus Christi and Lufkin. Tonka is now in the trailer with Latte for the Canadian rodeo run.

Initially, Walker's manager (read: husband Bryon) had planned to stay in the United States but that's changed.

"Last year we didn't go," said Walker, who is sponsored by IceVibe Boots, VetLase laser therapy, Panhandle

Slim, Justin, Relentless Boots, Coats Saddlery, Platinum, Justin Discount Boots, Omaha Truck & Trailer and Dr. Cliff Honnas at Texas Equine Hospital. "We'll go this year and see how they are. We're going to be up there for Calgary anyway. We just decided we'd do it."

Last year, Bryon Walker's past rodeo experience stateside served Mary Walker well. In Canada it will be a different story as Canadian rodeos didn't factor into Bryon's many NFR qualifications in the steer wrestling.

"It's going to be a new experience for both of us," said Mary Walker. "We are going to stay in Canada until after Calgary and then head down for Nampa and Cheyenne."



Diamonds & Dirt Features 5-Year-Old \$100K Slot Race

The 2014 Diamonds & Dirt Barrel Horse Classic, March 10-16, in Bryan, TX will feature the only 5 Year Old & Under \$100,000 Slot Race in the industry. The projected payouts will be 1st-\$100,000, 2nd-\$30,000, 3rd-\$25,000, 4th-\$20,000, 5th-\$15,000, 6th-\$10,000, 7th-\$7,500, 8th-\$6,500, 9th-\$5,500, 10th-\$5,500 with the payout being adjusted accordingly if all 50 slots don't sell. The horse and rider must be eligible to compete in 2014 Diamonds & Dirt Futurity and the payments will be due, Sept. 1 \$1,500, Nov. 1: \$1,500, Jan 1: \$2,000. Women Leaders and Obamacare Added to AHC's Issues Forum

The theme for the American Horse Council's National Issues Forum is "A Healthy Horse, A Healthy Industry." This year's Forum will be held on Tuesday, June 18, in Washington, DC during the AHC's annual convention, which will run from June 16 to 19 at the Washington Court Hotel.

In addition to reports on the progress of the National Equine Health Plan and the AHC's Marketing Consortium to reinvigorate the horse industry, the Forum will feature a panel on the future of the industry featuring four women who are leading national organizations this year and a presentation on how the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, better known as "Obamacare," will affect the horse industry.

"Women have always been leaders in the horse industry," noted Jay Hickey, AHC President. "But this year we have four outstanding women leading major national organizations. We thought it would be interesting to get their perspective on the future of various sectors in the industry." Scheduled to speak are Johne Dobbs, President of the American Quarter Horse Association, Dr. Ann Dwyer, DVM, President of the American Association of Equine Practitioners, Cynthia Richardson, President of the Arabian Horse Association, and Chrystine Tauber, President of the U.S. Equestrian Federation.

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, which was passed in March, 2010, is the most sweeping social legislation enacted since Medicare in 1965. It is expected to transform U.S. healthcare delivery and will affect members of the horse industry just like

others. "Obamacare is an issue that the industry must be preparing for on an ongoing basis," said Hickey. "Indeed some should have already taken steps to be ready. We hope that the presentation on Obamacare will help employers in the horse community understand their obligations under the new law."

Vanda McMurtry, an attorney with Davis & Harman in Washington, DC will explain what those in the industry should be doing now and what they should be prepared to do in the future under the new requirements. Mr. McMurtry has worked in the insurance industry and represented insurance companies for many years. He also has Washington experience.

The convention will include the AHC's Congressional Reception, the annual Congressional Ride-In, meetings of all AHC committees, the meeting of the Unwanted Horse Coalition and the AHC's Breed Roundtable, which brings together leaders of the horse industry to discus common issues of importance.

The annual Congressional Ride-In will take place on Wednesday, June 19. The Ride-In allows members of the horse community to meet with their elected representatives and federal officials to discuss important issues affecting them. All members of the horse community are encouraged to participate, even if they don't attend the AHC convention.

Jody Sheffield & Skip The Finances Cash In At Vegas

At the Fourth Annual Las Vegas Elks Helldorado Days Rodeo, held May 17-19, former Wrangler National Finals Rodeo qualifier Jody Sheffield and her gritty mare Skip The Finances ("Zoey") opened the rodeo with a 15.57 as the first runner in the first performance. Their run held through three performances and slack for a \$2,856 paycheck.

"It's really turned into a great rodeo," said Sheffield, who qualified for the NFR in 2011. "They went from having \$1,700 added to \$7,000 added. That's one of our best circuit rodeos. It's great that they've been able to grow like that when other rodeos are staying the same or going backwards."

This was Sheffield's first time to run Zoey, a 9-year-old homebred daughter of Financially out of Skip Chris Coy, by Skipabar Crystola, at the Helldorado Days, which is held in a temporary arena.

"The ground there was pretty good," said Sheffield, "but the more girls got on it, the shiftier it seems to get. You definitely want to be up at the top of the ground. It's a little pen with a crowd right on top of you with some trashy ground. That's her kind of a deal. She liked it."

Zoey has Sheffield within the Top 40 in the standings with a lighter schedule than most of her competitors.

"She's been doing really good. We did really well this winter at Tucson and Houston," said Sheffield, who is sponsored by Cowgirl Tuff, RodeoGenius.com, the Pawing Bracelet, Burns Saddlery and Equi-Sure supplements. "I came home and laid her off a little bit and then went back out. She's feeling really good. I'm excited."

After returning to South Weber, Utah, for Memorial Weekend, Sheffield will head to Oregon to start her summer run.

"I'll do Central Point, Union and Sisters again," said Sheffield, who won Sisters in 2012. "I'm going to go to Ponoka (Alberta, Canada) again and I might do a couple of other Canadian rodeos...

Strathmore and Innisfail, I'd like to go to. I'm going to go back to Cheyenne this year; like last year. Definitely hit Salinas again this year. Hopefully, I'll wind up in Vegas when it's all said and done."

Zoey is still the main horse in Sheffield's trailer, although she does have some colts that she hauls with her as well as Zoey's progeny at home.

Before she and her husband, Jesse, met, he had bred Zoey, then 2, to TTC Peppy Ike. She had a filly, Gold Dash Doc Peppy, now 6, who has produced two foals-- JS Skip The Finances, a 2-year-old filly by Get Rich R Die Tryin and a recently born colt by Waylons Sugar Cartel, an all-around grandson of Corona Cartel that the Sheffields recently gelded.

As for Zoey, Sheffield hasn't changed much of her program since she's made the NFR—"I really haven't changed a whole lot. I push cows on her all the time. My husband ropes on her. The secret to Zoey is definitely change things up and keep things fresh for her," she said, but she has added some new supplement to regime, namely F1 Noni and Equi-Sure. With the Equi-Sure, an all-natural digestive supplement, Sheffield has seen a big change in Zoey's attitude.

"She's a bit of grump and kind of gives me heck going in the pen sometimes," she laughed. "I've ran her on it five or six times and I've seen a really big difference with her on it."

Sheffield's also replaced Regumate with herbs to control Zoey's heat cycles.

"We were always really careful to take her off the Regumate and let her cycle," said Sheffield, "but now I'm hoping with the herbs I don't have to put her back on it. We'd definitely like to be able to get more babies out of her when she's done running."

Pay It Forward with Jill Moody

One of the most difficult elements of having to travel with our animals is being separated by miles and hours from our veterinarian. Local veterinarians are usually available, some associations mandate their presence, and they are lifesavers in emergency situations involving colic, tying up, or lacerations.

I appreciate and respect each and every vet but I am becoming a believer in the euphemism of "too many cooks spoil the stew". The opinion of too many vets can confuse the issues you have with your horse involving general health, soundness, and maintenance.

We all wish it could be as simple as a phone call to your vet at home who knows the history of your horse but don't be surprised if you can't get a suitable answer. Understand that it is difficult for him or her to make a diagnosis over the phone. They can give you an educated guess but it's not fair for you to expect an accurate analysis based on your judgment.

When you find yourself 1000 miles from home with a huge amount of investment in time and money, and the well being of your horse at stake, you may need to seek advice locally.

If this is the case here are my recommendations.

- Decide how urgent the situation is and if deemed as an emergency accept any professional help you can get.
- Ask around and find out who people trust as an equine vet in the area and make an appointment to see that person not just someone at that clinic.
- Let the vet do the diagnosing even if you think that you know the problem.
- Don't be afraid to ask questions and to be skeptical of the answers.

- Be careful in agreeing to any bizarre treatments and even to routine injections
- Use available resources to keep your vet apprised of the situation
- Never be afraid to ask for a second opinion. X-rays don't lie but they can be interpreted several ways under different eyes
- · Cheaper is not always cost effective
- Sometimes doing nothing is better than doing anything.

There are so many times when we are faced with difficult choices regarding the soundness and well being of our horses. Hopefully when the really tough questions arise we are close to the professionals who have gained our trust and respect. If put in a position where that is not an option then seek the best advise you can find from the most reputable people in the area. Most of all believe in yourself and the choices that you make knowing that you would only make an educated decision on a course of action or treatment that would benefit your horse.

Quam Runs Off With Nearly \$8K at The Classic

Rusty Rae Quam put on a bit of a clinic in Ponoka, Alberta over the weekend.

At The Classic Futurity on May 17-19, she didn't just win all three rounds (and the average by four-tenths of a second) aboard a granddaughter of Strawfly Special; she also nailed down second in the average on a Stoli filly.

"You never expect a horse to come in and win every round," said Quam, a former Canadian Finals Rodeo average winner. "Futurities nowadays are so tough that it's hard to think a 5-year-old will do that against the Rayel (Robinson) Littles and girls like that. And as for winning first and second, you always have one horse that you think will maybe do really good, but I've never have had anything like this happen."

Quam had three horses entered in The Classic. She jumped out and won the first round with the fastest time of the futurity on Lisa Groves' tiny black "Shadow," registered as ALG I Got Dat Look. And she was third in the first round aboard Dawn and Monty Gertner's mare Kat's Stoli Bar.

It was a near-repeat in Round Two, when Quam again won the round on Shadow by two-tenths (with the only other .4 of the event), and was second on "Stoli." Then, running last out, Shadow

won the short round and obviously, the average, to earn \$4,566. And Quam's sixth-place short-round run on Stoli was enough to slide her into second in the average, too, for another \$3,087. At the end of the day, Quam clocked five of the eight fastest runs of the futurity and pulled in \$7,653.

Shadow is so small – maybe 14'2 hands – that Quam and Groves at first wondered if she could clock with the other horses.

"She's just teeny tiny and doesn't weigh anything," said Quam. "But she's very gritty and aggressive. She gets very hooked on a barrel so I have to hustle her the whole run. She's a pretty cool little mare."

Quam had gone to the three spring futurities in Washington, where Shadow impressed her with her times of 17.4 and 17.5 on a standard set.

"Before that, she hadn't been on a regulation pattern, because all our stuff is so small up here," said Quam, who runs her in a twisted-wire O-ring snaffle. "At Pasco, she surprised me."

She may be tiny, but she's bred to race. The little black mare's sire, JD Look, is by Strawfly Special out of an On A High daughter that goes back to Easy Jet and Azure Te. On the bottom, she's out of a quarter-thoroughbred granddaughter of both Dash For Cash and Murrtheblurr.

"Shadow is so quick-footed that I really have to hustle to keep up with her," said Quam. "Her feet are super fast in a turn, which makes her turns fast."

The second-place sorrel mare is by Stoli and out of Bobby's Kit Kat – by the Foundation-bred Mr. Bobby McGee and out of a Dry Doc/Sugar Bars mare. She has an outstanding first barrel, but took a little longer to get confident.

"She's kind of a worrier and when we went down to Washington, she worried a lot and stressed a bit," said Quam. "I tell you what though, by that third futurity she knew why she was there and got confident and did a total 360. She's been working outstanding ever

since."

Quam has about 11 head to ride each day at the Wainwright home she shares with Dale Woodward. In addition to her client horses, she has a derby horse and is futurity campaigning a stallion owned by Woodward's parents. She also bought her own stud in January that she'll run next year – Foolish Perks is by Dash For Perks out of a Dr. Nick Bar/On The Money Red mare. Woodward also has two futurity colts of his own for next year and more babies hitting the ground this spring.

"If he's with me, he's working his butt off and if he's at home, he's working his butt off, so he maybe got the short end of the stick this year," laughed Quam.

The couple also runs 150 head of bucking horses (Outlaw Buckers Rodeo) that perform at American and Canadian pro rodeos, and buck younger stock at Canadian amateur rodeos they produce under their Rafter Anchor Rodeo brand.

"We're getting more into bucking horse futurities with our young stuff, and that's really fun," said Quam. "I enjoy going. It's fun to watch the colts buck."


With four stallions and a broodmare herd that foal out at the home of Quam's parents, the business is just beginning to buck its first 4- and 5-year-olds.

Meanwhile, on the patterned end of the performance horses, Quam will hit some more futurities in Brooks and Cardston, and looks for Shadow and Stoli to be entered this fall at the Fizz Bomb Classic and a couple of other futurities in Montana.

Despite her winners this weekend both being mares, she has no gender preference.

"It's just how bad they want to do it, right? If they're willing to run around them barrels, I'll kind of get on anything," said Quam. "They've got to want to do it. The futurities are so tough; they've got to want to do it pretty bad."

Kaye Stoesser won both long rounds of the derby on her 7-year-old Special Leader gelding Herbie Two, but then went longer in the short round to finish just sixth in the average. However, her second-round-winning 17.2 also won the Open race, bringing Stoesser's earnings to \$2,971.

Like Quam, who finished The Classic Futurity third last year on Tiny's Miracle, Braidy Howes bettered her third-place finish in the 2012 derby to come back and capitalize on Stoesser's trouble. Her derby average win aboard Howes In A Lincoln earned her \$2,543 (she placed last year on Howes A Loaded Shotgun).
