Primm and Pepper Repeat As NHSFR Champs

Rachel Primm of Washoe Valley, Nevada, ended her high school rodeo career with a second consecutive barrel racing championship at the National High School Finals Rodeo, held July 17-21 in Gillette, Wyo.

The 18-year-old cowgirl was once again partnered with the fabulous Proud Red Pepper, an 8-year-old gelding by Proudest Effort out of the Dash Ta Fame mare, JBS Beanie Baby, that was trained by former National Finals Rodeo qualifier Barb Merrill of Axtell, Utah.

"I think it was harder the second time," said Primm, who won the title in 2010 despite only owning Pepper a few months. "I had more pressure and expectations this year."

Unlike last year when Primm went into the short round, leading the average, this year, she was 3/10ths behind in second to Utah's McKale Hadley.

Primm won the first round in 17.316 with Hadley right on her heels with a 17.368. "The ground was really deep, but I was really happy with my run. I thought it was a really smooth run," she commented.

Hadley got the jump on her in the second round, when the Plain City, Utah, barrel racer took second to Monica McClung of May, Okla. riding Guys VooDoo Bug.

"I ran another 17.3, but his barrels were a little too tight," said Primm. "If I run him bigger, he can keep his momentum in the turns."

In the short go, Primm ran 11th on the ground, one spot a head of Hadley, and turned in the fastest run of the rodeo a 16.932.

"I think if I had gone first I would have been more nervous," said Primm, who also won the 2010 Equi- Thunder Games in Las Vegas last December. "I let him take his first barrel a little wider and I lifted with my hand at the second barrel instead of just bumping him, and his head popped up a little, and I whipped him for the first time coming home."

One of Pepper's quirks is reluctance to run hard outside under the lights, so Primm was going to make sure he fired.

Primm's immediate plans are to make more outside night runs as she finishes filling her WPRA permit, which she bought at the end of March when she turned 18. She placed third at her first pro rodeo in Auburn, Calif., this spring and only lacks a little money to meet the \$1,000 requirement for a WPRA card.

"I want to have my permit filled by the end of September so I can buy card in October and go for Rookie next year," said Primm, who wanted to thank her father Roger Primm for all his support as well as Neil and Barb Merrill for helping her with Pepper.

Former NFR qualifier Lita Scott of Reno, Nevada, who serves as Primm's mentor, will travel with her a little next year to show her the ropes of the rodeo road.

Adams Brothers Go Old School

SALINAS, Calif. - If some of the legends who have roped in the huge arena at the California Rodeo throughout its 101-year history were watching this year's edition from above on July 24, the team roping winners made them proud, and brought back fond memories of a by-gone time.

Brothers Jay and Randon Adams from Logandale, Nev., have significantly cut back their rodeo schedules in 2011, but Salinas is one they just wouldn't miss, and they navigated through the grueling five-round competition with German motorcar precision. They placed in four of the rounds at this Wrangler Million Dollar Tour Gold rodeo presented by Justin Boots, and their total time of 43.4 seconds was 1.6 seconds better than the second place team of Wade Wheatley and seven-time World Champion Clay O'Brien Cooper.

The way the Adams went about preparing for this year's Rodeo (pronounced Ro-day-o in the California Vaquero tradition), well, that was as traditional and old-school as it comes.

"We had to practice to come here, so we roped five steers out in the pasture," said younger brother Jay, who handles the heading side for their team. "This place is so different, with the 35-foot score and the huge arena, it's like roping out in the pasture sometimes. It's just Western.

"Randon said we should try to rope some of the older ones (in the pasture) so they'd handle better, but it was getting pretty dark, so we just had to run the first ones we could find. We roped five of them out in that 80-acre pasture, and then loaded up and came over." The Adams brought a couple of nice young horses to Salinas, Transmission and Rooster, that were bred and raised by their father, Wes, who died earlier this year.

"They're half-brothers by our stud, both 7 years old," Jay Adams said. "My dad was smart. He always said, 'Let's raise fast horses. You can't replace speed.' I got a call from our mom right after we roped. When I told her we had won it, she said, 'If you see your dad there, give him a hug and a kiss for me.'

"I was already pretty emotional anyway, because I've always wanted to win this rodeo. But to win it with my brother on those horses now."

When I heard that, I broke down. I'm as happy as I've ever been to win a rodeo. "When we decided to slow down our rodeo schedule and focus more on our family business, we thought about selling Transmission, the horse I rode here. We had some interest in him, and he would bring the dollars, but he was my dad's favorite."





No Need for New Tricks

Over the past few weeks, the senior citizens have been out in the rodeo arena! We aren't talking about the riders, we are talking about the horses. Last week Tammy Fischer rode Easy Dash Oak, the 16 year young dynamo, to \$27,000 in earnings at Calgary and the team has been winning all over. This week, not only did Tana Poppino win Nampa and place at Cheyenne on 16 year old Perryman Star (Amigo) but Lindsay Hampton rode her 16 year old gelding Lyles Dasher to 3rd Place in the Average at Salinas. At Woodward, OK, Lanita Powers pulled out the 17 year old Wahini Cash and beat em all. Age is just a mindset for horses too I guess.


Poppino and Perryman Star know each other pretty well qualifying for the NFR in 2006, 2007, and 2010 and now they are back in contention in 2011 being just a couple thousand out of that #15 spot, but don't tell that to Poppino. "The standings only matter on Oct 1 and about the middle of December every year," said Poppino. Last year the pair blazed through the year until the Fourth of July and then had to hand on until the NFR this year the beginning of the year has been slow, with her winning only 12k before July but now the pair are over \$30,000 in earnings and headed up the standings in a hurry. Over the last year she has brought Perryman Star back to working as well as he ever has in his career which he has over \$400k in earnings to show for.

We caught up with her for a couple questions:

Q: What has given you the boost over the last couple weeks? **Poppino:** About a month ago I sent my grey horse (Goose or Doc Hickorys Cross) home so I could just focus on Amigo. Our timing had just sucked all summer, when you are running just inches from the barrels you need good timing. I hit barrels at Reno, Vernal, Colorado Springs, and Laramie. So I think just running Amigo has allowed me to get our timing fixed and now our timing is really good.

Q: What rodeos have you been to lately and what are you headed to next?

Poppino: Last week we ran in the slack in Nampa then drove all day afterward to make it to Cheyenne to run in the slack the next morning. After we left there we drove all night to get to Pretty Prairie (KS), we had quite a trip but got there at 3:30 in the morning and slack started at 8. My truck broke down on the way



and wouldn't run over 45. It was funny because I finally got it going faster going down a big hill and so I told the girls we were just going to keep going no matter what, we came to a stop sign and I told them to look both ways because we didn't dare lose our momentum, well sure enough we needed to turn at the stop sign! We had to turn around and go back to limping my truck into Pretty Prairie. The rodeo committee at Pretty Prairie found out about my truck troubles and right away in the morning were figuring out what parts I needed, they couldn't find the parts so they found someone to make one up until we could find the right part. They were just great and so helpful, rodeo people are just the best people in the world! Luckily, I also got a chance to win money in Pretty Prairie (2nd for \$1,363).

This week we are in Deadwood Thursday, then Burwell that night, Burlington Friday, Saturday in Cheyenne and hopefully Sunday too, then on to the Kansas rodeo run (Hill City, Dodge City, and Phillipsburg, etc) and eventually we are headed out to Pro Continued on Page 12

the Northwest.

Q: Is there anything special you have to do for Amigo to keep him running at his age?

Poppino: He gets EquiPride everyday and if I slip or suspect he might have pulled something I give him NutraWound (Total Health Enhancement) to help him heal. I keep him in good shape, which isn't a big deal in the summer when you are traveling all the time, but even in the winter he needs to stay in good shape. He takes quite a bit of warming up to run well so that helps keep him limber and in shape. If you have an older horse that you know can win, keep after it and keep trying to get him right because it is worth it.



while people traveled to Wyoming, Utah, Kansas and all through the middle part of the country between their runs at Salinas, Richman just stayed for the week, got there Tuesday and left just Monday. She didn't really go to the winter rodeos and used a dominating spring and well placed wins since, to keep her in the #9 position in the World. Even though the pair has rarely made more than 2 runs in a weekend they are closing in on her second NFR in a row. We caught up with her for a few quick questions.

Q: What is the key running that well at Salina?


Richman: At Salinas you have to make 3 good runs, the third is out in the middle of nowhere. Every year I have been there, if you make 3 good runs you will be in the short go. There I am so confident in Stitch that I can really just ride her and I know she will do well.

The barrels are on the track and there is no gate you are just walking around on the track and they call your number. It is a long ways to the first and then only 3-4 strides to the second and then a long ways to the third. The first and second barrel are right on the fence so it is a challenging set up and you have to ride an honest horse there.

Q: What are your plans for the rest of the year?

Richman: Staying close to home and going to the Wilderness Circuit rodeos then to Caldwell and the Northwest. I won't be going to Kansas just staying closer to home and keeping the trips between rodeos short. I think the longest trip will be about 5 hours between rodeos. It worries me to make my horse travel that much so when I don't have to travel hard, I take advantage and travel as little as possible and take my time when I do travel.


Q: What has been the biggest challenge throughout the year? **Richman:** I haven't had too many challenges this year, in past





years she was tying up so I was dealing with that which was pretty challenging. A switch in my feeding program has taken care of that. This year I didn't really go over the winter so I had to play catch up and Stitch really won over the spring and then I have been just placing along.

Q: What has been the highpoint of the year up until now? Richman: Salinas has to be right up there, it is such a big presti-Pro Continued on Page 17






